SILK INDUSTRY SERIOUS IN JAPAN

(By the Canadian Press)

TOKIO, Aug. 18.—Of all signs of industrial depression in Japan that of the silk industry is the most serious since it is the greatest, representing one third of the export trade of the country.

The silk industry is passing through a critical period. The application of the indemnity Act has had no effect in arresting the decline in prices. It has had rather the contrary effect by increasing the use of Chinese silk. It is now generally known that the volume of consumption in Canada and the United States has not fallen but that the Chinese and Italian product has been increasing. During the period when silk exports from Japan underwent a marked decrease the sale of Italian and Chinese silk has gained enormously. The present depression

in Japanese silk circles there are, cannot be regarded as due to general business stagnation in other countries, but due to the rising competition of other producers.

China has mulberries which grow healthily without fertilization and had a cheap and abundant labor supply, which is excellently adapted to cocoon raising. It is said that Canton alone can produce more mulberry leaves than Japan, but they are grown more widely in the Yangtze valley and they yield from four to seven crops in a year against two in Japan. To meet this competition, which will assume a greater place in the future, Japan must reduce the cost of production so as to undersell the Chinese. FREDERICTON, N. B., Aug. 18.—An interesting momento of the first repairs to the steeple of Wilmot United Church in this city, made in 1887, was discovered by workmen employed in rejuvenating the tall spire recently. A small square of lead covering taken from the wrist band of "Thumbs Up" the large human hand surmounting the spire was found to have inscribed on it the names of James W. Briggs and the late John F.
