Hints for the Motorist

When Cylinders Wear Out
Adjustment Compensates For Nearly All Other Wear

IN THE NORMAL LIFE OF A MOTOR CAR ENGINE, it is usually the wearing of its cylinders that first seriously interrupts its useful service. Bearings can be tightened and valves ground repeatedly to keep it in satisfactory operation, but there is no adjustment by means of which pistons can be kept fitted to cylinder bores. When the charge leaks between pistons and cylinders, to such an extent that compression can no longer be maintained, the pistons slap noisily and oil escapes upward so freely as to seriously foul the spark-plugs, and when the fitting of new piston rings does not right matters, the owner is "up against" a serious repair job—one that is sure to come to him if he runs the same car long enough, no matter how good care he gives it. Perhaps by that time, he is ready to trade in or otherwise dispose of the car, but if not, he must decide what to do to restore the engine to good working condition. What is desired to emphasize here is that this problem is of sufficient importance to demand careful investigation and the best mechanical advice and that it should not be settled on the whim of the first garage man who is ready with a snap judgment. The first move should be to have the engine disassembled and measured each of the cylinder bores in several horizontal planes, both in line with the transverse to the length of the block, with micrometer calipers, to ascertain how great the wear has been and to what extent the bores have become oval. These measurements will enable him to decide whether good results can be obtained simply by fitting larger (oversize) pistons and corresponding piston rings. If the verdict is "no," there are the following alternatives: To buy a new cylinder block and new standard pistons and rings, or to have the cylinder bores re-bored to true circular cylindrical shape but of slightly larger diameter, by boring out and fitting oversize pistons. The decision in either matter of obtaining guaranteed estimates as to what the parts and labor involved in the two operations will respectively cost and then making the choice, bearing in mind that the former is somewhat the more straightforward and certain of good results than the latter. If the latter is chosen, be sure as to the quality of the workmanship to be obtained and as to whether properly oversized pistons are obtainable. Don't have either job done unless the car that carries the engine is worth it.

SHELLAC ON CYLINDER HEAD GASKETS

As if too much force is required in breaking the joint, there is some danger of causing the head as well as of tearing the gasket.

SPARK SETTING FOR IDLE OPERATION

W. T. T. asks: When an engine is being run idle, should the spark be retarded or advanced? Which produces less wear and tear? It is a little difference, but it is worth noting, the less wear and tear is to be expected and, if an engine will not run very slowly on advanced spark, it is better to retard it. The slight additional heat and carbon formation that may be caused by the delayed spark will not be serious, considering the short idling periods that are required.

Notice Re-obstructing Drains on Public Highways

The attention of the public is called to Section 65 of the Road Act which reads as follows:—

"No person shall obstruct or impede the water course of any drain draining any highway in order to facilitate his access from his property to such highway, and it shall be the duty of every owner or occupier of land fronting on the highway to see that such drains are kept open at the point of approach through any gateway, lane or other way from the property owned or occupied by him to such highway, and any offence against this provision shall be punishable by fine not exceeding ten dollars."

All Inspectors and Overseers are hereby required to see that the Act in this respect is strictly complied with.
