Turn button to open clean-out door. Use scraper and pan, and flues can be cleaned out in a minute.

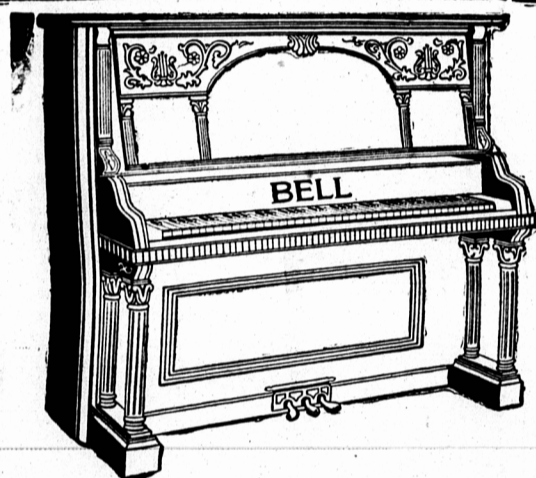

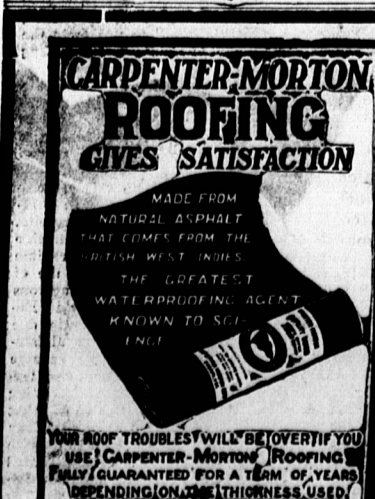

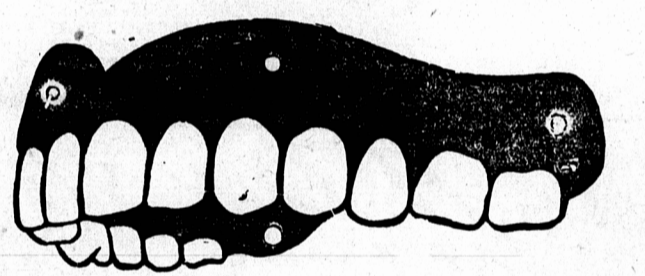

# STAR FLOUR

FOR BREAD AND PASTRY

## PUFF PASTE

1 lb STAR flour, 3-4 lb butter, water. Dust some flour on board, lay butter on it and roll in thin sheets, set butter aside to keep cold, mix flour to cold water to a soft dough, roll out thin, lay butter on it till all used, then roll dough up tight, beat hard with rolling pin to drive butter into it, fold up and roll out three or four times, now ready for use.
