### Many Matters For Quebec House

QUEBEC, Que., Oct. 27.—The last session of the present Quebec legislature will start on December 2, and advance information is to the effect that it will be one of the longest and the least contentious on record. A mass of minor legislation is expected to be dealt with by the legislature, thus clearing the decks for a provincial by-election which is expected to take place either in the spring or the following autumn.

Radical changes in the Succession Duties Act may be before the members. Last session this act was revised so as to lighten the burden on estates up to \$50,000, property valued up to \$25,000 being entirely exempt. The rates on estates over \$50,000 were increased, in some instances running as high as 35 percent. It is thought that there may be a scaling down on the higher rates on the ground that too heavy taxation has a tendency to discourage accumulation of large fortunes and no matter what precautions have been taken, means have been found whereby the principles of the law have not always been observed.

The knotty problem which arose last session over the Jewish school question in Montreal and was met by the passing of an act setting up a Jewish school commission is in process of adjustment, it is believed. Conferences between the Montreal Board of School Commissioners and representative Jews looking to the retention of the Jewish pupils in

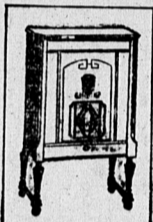

Protestant schools are now going on and are expected to be successful. If an agreement is reached, the Jewish School Commission Act will be repealed.

Legislation is expected to give effect to the results of study on the question of helping farmers in matters of bovine tuberculosis. At the present time, the Federal Government, when condemning a cow in a protected area, grants the farmer a small compensation for each cow which is destroyed when found to answer the tuberculin test. Complaints have been frequent that the compensation is inadequate and the Provincial Government may make a supplementary grant.

The vexed problem of the exact legal status of hotels for taxation purposes will be brought before the

legislature. There is a conflict of opinion between the municipalities in the province and the hotel-keepers on this point. The hotel-keepers claim their premises cannot be taxed except as realty, while municipalities contend they have the right to levy business taxes on hotels.

Premier Taschereau will lead the government forces. He has now been Quebec Premier for 11 years. There has been some gossip in papers in the province suggesting that Camille-Houde, opposition leader, may retire from this office in order to devote all his time to his duties as Mayor of Montreal. Mr. Houde, himself, has denied this and has promised that when the legislature opens he will again be found as chief critic of the Government.

### BRITISH INDUSTRIES AT PARIS SHOW

(Canadian Press) PARIS, Oct. 29.—Aircraft, aero engines and flying accessories will represent the British industry at the Paris Aero Show in November and December this year. Military aircraft, aircooled and water cooled engines, light aeroplanes, metal construction, aerodrome and airways lighting, and a variety of accessory equipment will be found on British stands.

The successful water-cooled super-charged motors of approximately 500 horsepower which have enabled the British aircraft constructor to produce the fastest military aircraft in the world will be exhibited by way of contrast and comparison the expert
