Synopsis of Canadian North-West Homestead Regulations.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, exceeding 8 and 28, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.
Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated, or if the homesteader desires, he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Ottawa, or the local agent receiving authority for some one to make entry for him.
The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans:
(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
(2) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.
(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.
Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of intention to apply for patent.

HORSE NOTES.

The following is clipped from a late issue of the Boston Globe; it is from the pen of Frank G. Trout, the celebrated author and writer on the "Trotting Horse." Bingen, whom George Leavitt brought to New England ten years ago, has founded a family which promises to be the greatest New England has ever known. Already it is the most popular, and in nearly every training stable in this section the prize pupil is a Bingen. A score of sons of Bingen are standing for service hereabouts and all are having a heavy patronage. Breeding is on the boom in New England, and it is a Bingen boom, too.

There is not a stallion in America who reproduces himself in looks and natural speed more uniformly than Bingen. A beautiful animal himself so he stamps his colts, and everyone of them can go fast.

The one criticism that can be made of the Bingen is that they have too much speed. They get over the ground so easily that extreme speed seems no effort for them. This deceives many men, for there is so little exertion that it hardly seems possible there can be any strain.

There will be sensational colt trotters sired by Bingen, but his greatest fame as a sire will come from those of his get who are not raced until matured.

His record is 2:04 obtained last October at Louisville, Ky, trotting the middle half mile in one minute and a quarter of a second. He is the sire of Commodore Leyard, the handsome four year old colt owned by Dr. Strickland of this city.

NEW YORK, Jan. 14.—A Berlin despatch to The Herald dated Thursday, says:—"Prince Buelo left here for Rome this evening. I saw him before he started and he authorized me to make the following communication:—
"Neither the Kaiser nor anybody else in Germany dreams of bringing the slightest pressure upon France at the expense of French national dignity at the conference, where there should be neither conquerors nor conquered. Germany stands for equality of opportunity in the trade of Morocco, the open door for all nations alike, and if this principle be accepted by others it is expected the conference will have a successful issue. Germany seeks no advantages which are not to be shared by all alike."
