### It is the Second Building of the Sort in Prussia;—Only Those Wishing it Are Cremated

BERLIN, Jan. 2 (Special)—Berlin made another step towards modernity the other day by erecting an inaugurating its first crematorium. The building is the second of its kind in Prussia, and its predecessor was opened only a couple of months ago. As a matter of fact, cremation is thought to be a questionable proceeding by quite a large part of the population, as the regulations as to the formalities exacted before permission for cremation clearly testify. In Prussia a man may be cremated only if he states it as his emphatic wish in his will, or when he signs a separate statement attested by a commissioner of oaths.

### HYDRO-AEROLANE LAUNCHING WAYS FOR BATTLESHIPS.

Launching ways for hydro-aeroplanes, occupying so little space that they may be swivelled on a big-gun turret, or moved to any desired location on a ship, have been devised by Captain W. I. Chambers, U. S. N., who is in charge of navy aviation work. Such a device, which may be dismantled and stowed in a space no more than 8 ft long and wide, is an interesting departure from the cumbersome and unwieldy apparatus previously designed for aeroplane launching. Views of the way appears in the January Popular Mechanics Magazine.
