If our laws discourage the making of drunkards' wives there isn't anything we can do. We have done our best, but the odds against us were too great. Mrs. Nation has asked that the property be restored to her, as she desires to sell it and devote the proceeds to a school for neglected children she is building at Eureka Springs Ark.

CLERGYMAN'S WIFE SUES FOR DIVORCE

NEW YORK, Aug. 1--Accusations against the Rev. George T. Carter in which the name of a fifteen-year-old girl figures, are made in a suit for divorce filed in Paterson by Mrs. Anna B. Carter. Her husband was for many years pastor of the Baptist church at Old Bridge, Middlesex County, N. J., and at the present time is said to be in charge of a church in New York state.

The incidents alleged in the suit are said to have occurred at Old Bridge two years ago, and at that time forced the Rev. Mr. Carter to abandon his pastorate. Mrs. Carter declares the attentions of her husband to Elsie Smith aroused so much talk in the community that he was called before a conference of Baptist ministers to explain.

The clergyman is alleged to have been as attentive to the girl as a sweetheart although he is forty years old. The gossip was of such a nature, says Mrs. Carter, that she left her husband.

After Carter left Old Bridge he is said to have been expelled from the Baptist Church, but it is not known if he was reinstated or joined another denomination. Following his expulsion he continued to live in New Jersey for some time, and engaged in the business of paper hanging which he had learned in his youth. He travelled from town to town in Middlesex County, but is said to have been forced to abandon the work.

To make a living he then sold Bibles and religious books. From this occupation he is said to have gradually taken up church work, and so re-established himself.

Elsie Smith, the girl involved by Mrs. Carter, has been lost sight of but it is understood in Paterson that her alleged friendship for the minister ceased when he left Old Bridge, and that she has since married. She is said to reside somewhere near her old home.


Mrs. Carter now lives with her parents at Vernon Township, Suffolk County about thirty-five miles from Paterson. Her father is a prosperous farmer. She is about thirty-five years old.

Addison B. Rosencraft, of Paterson, Mrs. Carter's lawyer, says he may ask that a referee take the testimony at her home.

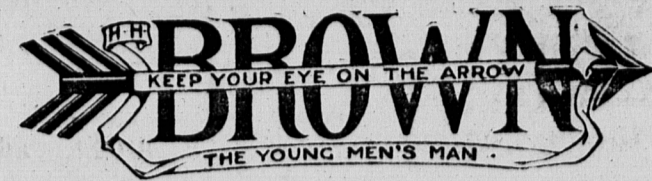
