

DESTROYING MOTHS.

Rugs or upholstered furniture infected with moths may be freed by a thorough soaking in naphtha, which will kill the eggs as well as the old moths. Articles so treated, however, should not be brought near a flame or heat of any kind until the fumes have evaporated.

fore relaying it. To prevent further trouble, sprinkle the carpet with salt once a week before sweeping. Camphor balls or powdered camphor is usually used in keeping moths out of clothes that hang in closets or are put away for the season when cedar chests are not at hand. Turpentine sprinkled around the crevices of closets, drawers and boxes containing clothing is also effective. Before putting clothes or furs away, however, expose them to the hot sun. Better yet, press those clothes which will not be hurt by the process with a hot iron to kill the moth eggs.

APPENDICITIS AND WHITE FLOUR
