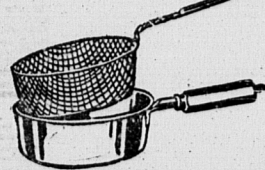


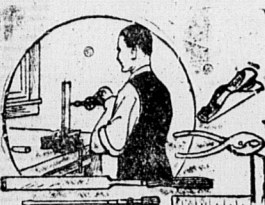

CROP REPORT

Below will be found a brief synopsis of telegraphic reports received at the Head Office of the Bank of Montreal from its Branches. The Branch Managers have complete and intimate knowledge of each local situation and are in close touch with crop conditions in all sections of the districts mentioned.

GENERAL

Fairly general rains have benefited crops in the Prairie Provinces, especially in parts of Alberta where moisture was urgently needed.

Continued fine, warm weather is needed. Hay making has been hindered by rains, but a crop above the average in many places is being harvested. Grains are heading out and promise well.

PRAIRIE PROVINCES

ALBERTA NORTHEASTERN AREA — Wheat is 80% headed out and, following rain, indications are for a fair crop. Some isolated hail losses are reported.

Several family picnics have been among the events of the week. The ideal weather afforded an opportunity for a day's outing. On Tuesday about forty gathered on the shore near Mr. Robert MacNutt's home.

PROVINCE OF QUEBEC

Haying is being carried on under satisfactory conditions and a crop larger than the average and of good quality is being harvested. Oats are heading out well, and a good crop of barley is indicated.

PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

Haying is nearing completion and an average yield is reported. The cutting of fall wheat is becoming general and threshing has commenced, with an average yield of good quality.

MARITIME PROVINCES

Continued fine, warm weather is needed. Hay making has been hindered by rains, but a crop above the average in many places is being harvested.

PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

Tree fruits are doing well in the Okanagan and Kootenay districts, and there should be sufficient irrigation water for the season.
