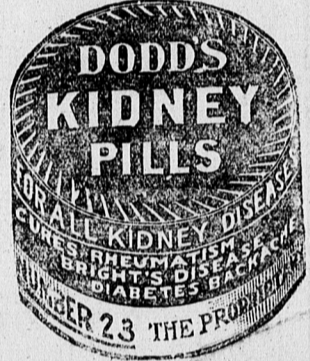

AT THE AMHERST FAIR.

AMHERST, N. S., Dec. 8—The tenth annual Maritime Winter Fair was opened to the public at 10 o'clock yesterday morning and the formal opening took place at 2 o'clock.

The show is undoubtedly the finest ever held in the Maritime Provinces, stock coming from as far as Ontario, which has figured in many of the big shows.

In every department this show is ahead of that of former years. The poultry display is one of the strong features.

About fifteen hundred live fowls, beside a great display of geese, turkeys, ducks, bantams and pigeons are shown. There is also an excellent display of dressed poultry.

In cattle the Island is well represented, more so in the dairy class than in beef cattle.

In the milk test the Island is represented in both quality and quantity. Messrs Roper Bros. have eight entries and A. McCoull four entries in fat cattle.

Messrs. S. C. Lane and A. Boswell represent the Island in sheep the exhibit of which is the largest ever held in the Maritime Provinces.

The Island exhibits number about one hundred in all.

There are also a large number of entries from the Island in swine being many more than last year.

The fruit show is a splendid one, excelling by far that of previous years. The Island is as well represented in this as in other departments.

The seed display is another noteworthy feature there being 30 entries of wheat from P. E. Island, 25 of oats, 20 of barley and about 20 of potatoes, peas, flour and buckwheat.

THE OYSTER INDUSTRY.

OTTAWA, Dec. 6—The greater part of the session was devoted to a discussion, initiated by Mr. Warburton of P. E. Island urging the Government to safeguard and promote the oyster industry of Maritime Provinces.

He pointed out that the fisheries were being rapidly depleted and proposed that the Dominion Government should take the control of the oyster grounds and sell them to private individuals or corporations who could go in for planting and propagation of oysters, as was successfully done in the United States, Japan and other parts of the world.

He thought the freehold system would be better than the leasehold and suggested that the province might receive compensation by the payment of royalties on the production.

Mr. Fraser endorsed Mr. Warburton's views.

Mr. Broder deplored the depletion of the fisheries and expressed the hope that the question of jurisdiction would be solved by a decision of the Supreme Court which would empower the Dominion Government to lease the fisheries as well as to issue licenses for fishing. He was not in favor of selling them outright.

THE BRITISH ELECTIONS.

LONDON, Dec. 6—The results of yesterday merely confirm the opinion formed from results of Saturday's contests, that the Unionists now have no possible hope of replacing the Liberal government in power. The only question remaining is whether the Liberals will return with a larger or smaller majority.

To gain a bare majority in the new parliament the Unionists must make a net gain of 62 seats. Thus far with 130 pollings they only have a net gain of 5 seats.

They have gained 11 and the Liberals 6 seats. The gain for the Unionists on Saturday was while the Liberals gained 4. The Unionists yesterday gained 4 and the Liberals 2 seats. A continuation at this rate of progress, would fulfill the Unionist prediction, that the Asquith Cabinet will be a greatly weakened majority and would be more than ever dependent upon their Irish and Labor allies.
