**Anglo-Japanese Alliance Under Discussion**

LONDON, June 29—The question of the advisability of renewing the Anglo-Japanese alliance came before a conference of Empire Premiers today but owing to the British Prime Minister having to attend a conference in connection

with the settlement of the coal strike the discussion was limited to two brief statements by Lord Curzon and the Right Hon. Mr. Balfour. Both speeches were confidential and at the close no communique was issued to the press but it is understood they were very non-committal in character.

SYDNEY, June 29—That the present criminal docket is the most wretched with which he ever had to deal in any part of the province was the emphatic statement made by Chief Justice Harris in his preliminary address to the Cape Breton County Grand Jury today.

**"Israelites" Routed by Mounted Police**

CAPTOWN, June 29—A native religious sect, which calls itself the "Israelites" under a "prophet" named Enoch, who refused to evacuate Government land at Bulhoek, near Queenstown, Cape Colony, has been forcibly ejected, losing 171 killed and 126 wounded in a fight with mounted Cape police.

For some years past the Government had permitted the "Israelites" to celebrate "Passover" on a common, but each year a growing number of pilgrims remained behind on what they called "holy ground" until a village of some 350 huts had sprung up. The sect forbade anybody to enter the village, or to recognize any authority except orders from "Jehovah, the God of Israel," interpreted by Enoch, the prophet.

The Government some time ago endeavored to register the settlement but the police were obliged to withdraw to avoid bloodshed.

Peaceful efforts by the Secretary of Native Affairs and others to induce the "Israelites" to withdraw failed.

Finally a force of 800 mounted police moved from Queenstown to demand the surrender of the village. With shouts of "Jehovah says we must fight," 4,000 natives charged the police with swords and assegais, the women urging on the men with wild religious chants. The police let them come on until within 30 yards, and then fired with the result stated. Thereupon the prophet Enoch surrendered and the village is to be demolished.

**Churchill Advocates Closer Union Between Canada and West Indies**

LONDON, June 29—"The more the West Indies are linked up with Canada the more certain the future will be," said Right Hon. Winston Churchill, Secretary of State for the Colonies, at a banquet tendered His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales by the West Indies committee on Saturday.

Mr. Churchill pointed out that at the Imperial Conference, Canada really was not completely commercially or geographically associated with the tropical West Indies, and he was confident that the more these two great portions of the British Empire were interested in each other the greater the benefits would be for both.

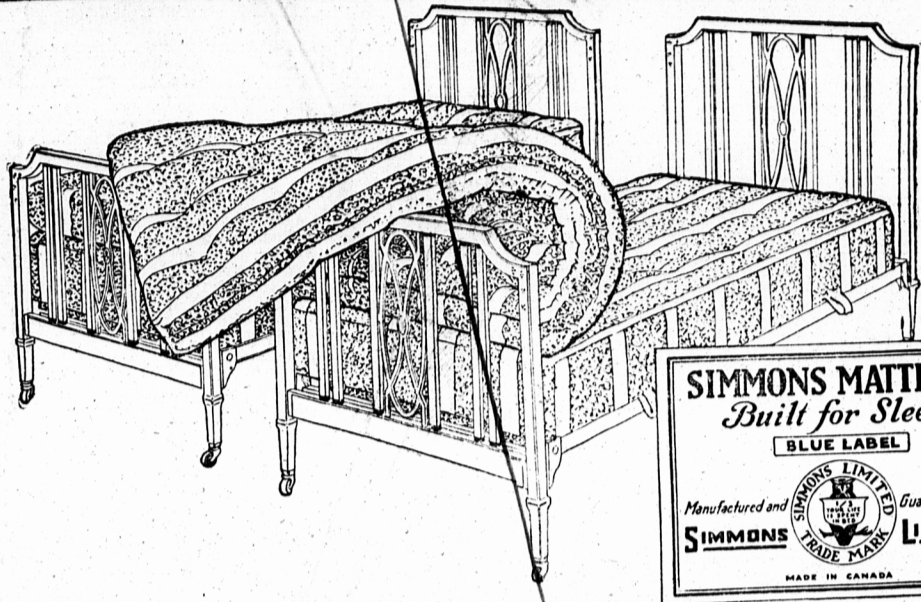
