CANADA'S LIVE STOCK AT BUFFALO.

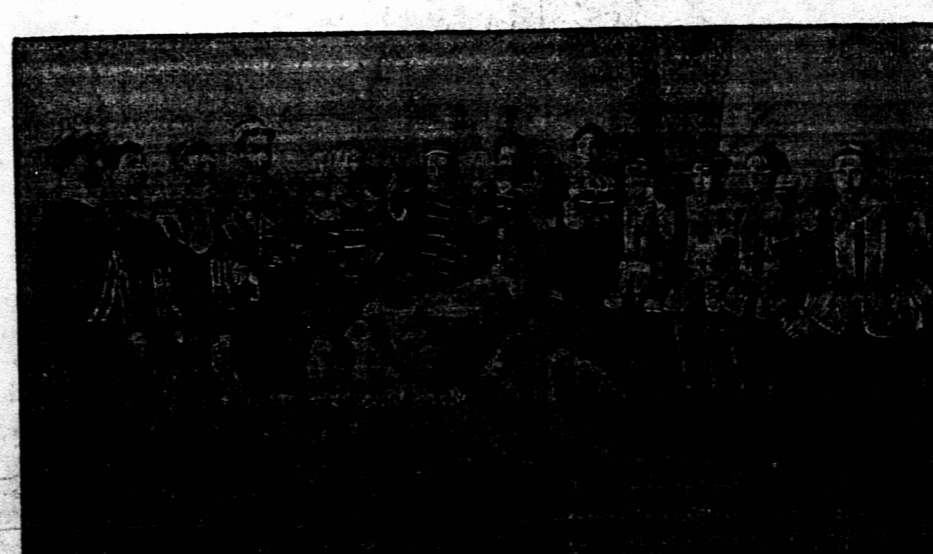
