JOHN R. BOWNESS, Bedouque, left yesterday for Boston, to see his son who is seriously ill in that city with typhoid fever.

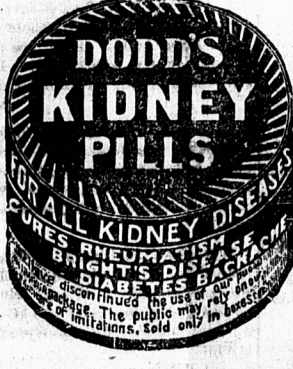
MRS. J. A. MORRISON and son Heywood who have been visiting in Bonshaw, returned to their home in Summerside yesterday.

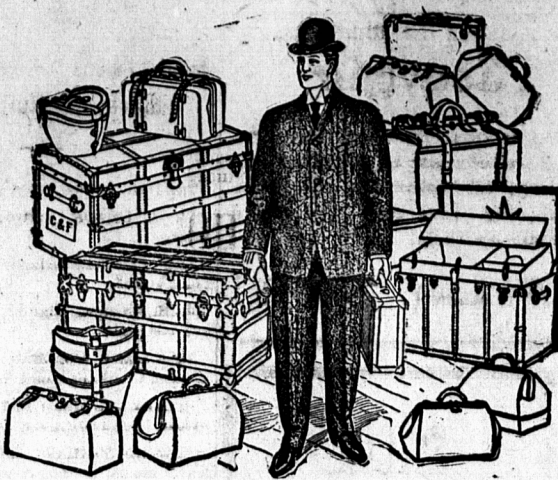

Vegetarians will find in the September DELINEATOR a recipe for vegetable curry, given by Swami Abhedananda, leader of the New York Vedanta Society. He first fries his vegetables separately in oil until they are a little more than half cooked. He then sets them aside and fries in oil, also, cloves, cardamom seeds, bay leaf, finely chopped chill peppers, etc. He then dissolves the curry powder in salted water, after which he mixes the ingredients together adding the curry last. The entire mixture is then placed in a tightly covered pan to cook gently over a slow fire until all of the vegetables become tender.

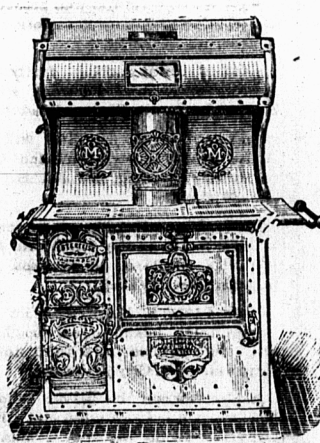
