Wall Street's Hopes For Spring Rally Are Revived

NEW YORK, March 13—(AP)—Wall Street's hopes for a spring rally in the stock market took on new life last week.

On Friday the market snapped out of its coma with the largest average gain in more than two months. The forward momentum carried through to Saturday's short session when key issues moved up fractions to more than a point.

A number of rail stocks advanced, but Union Pacific fell back 1 1/2 to 81 1/4. Atlantic Coast Line slipped to 38 1/8 and Southern Railway tipped down to 35 1/2. Nickel Plate gained a point at 76 and Baltimore and Ohio swung 1/2 point ahead to 9 7/8.

Among industrial stocks gains were posted for U. S. Steel, National Steel, General Motors, Chrysler, Packard, Skelly Oil, Standard Oil (N.J.), Allied Chemical, U. S. Gypsum, and International Paper.

Canadian issues were regular. International Nickel gained 1/4. Dome Mines was off 1/8 and Hiram Walker down 1/2. On the curb, Yellowknife dipped 1/8.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks inched up 1/8 of one point to 63.9, a peak since 64.6 was touched on Feb. 4.
