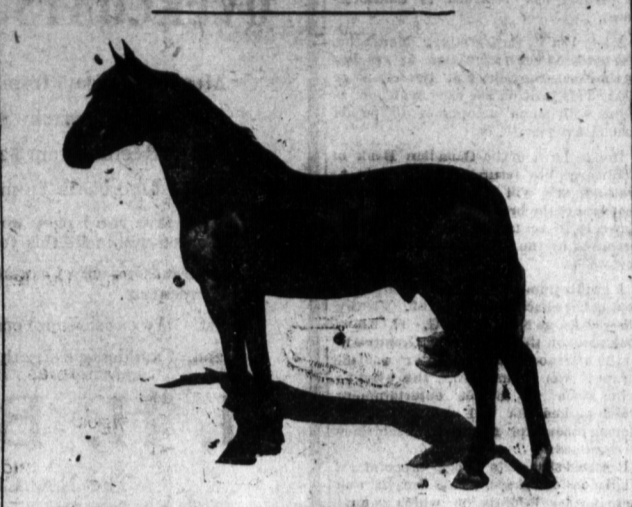

WORDS OF PRAISE FOR OAKLEY BARON, 4, 2.23

Horse Owned By W. S. McKie of Charlottetown Gets a Write Up in the American Horse Breeder—The Breeding of This Fine Horse



There is no family which has secured a great reputation, or is better maintaining its prestige, than that founded by Baron Wilkes (2.18), the old hero of Maplehurst Farm, of which Col. John F. Thayer, Lancaster, Mass., is proprietor. One of the best sons of Baron Wilkes, as a race-horse and a sire, is Oakley Baron (2.00), the premier stallion at Hudson River Stock Farm, Jacob Ruppert, proprietor.

Oakley Baron, the subject of the present sketch, is owned by W. S. McKie, one of the leading horsemen of Charlottetown, P. E. I., the section where buyers formerly went to obtain good horses and where their foot-steps may yet lead, providing sties like Oakley Baron we sent there and bred to the good mares found upon the Island.

Oakley Baron is by Baron Oaks, a full brother to Oakland Baron, which died young, leaving few colts. The dam of Oakley Baron was Katie Kingward, by Kingward (2.25), and his second dam was Kate Stranger, by Stranger, who was out of the famous trotting mare Goldsmith Maid (2.14). Kingward is the sire of Pelegus (2.10), John (2.14), and others in the standard list. Kingward was by Onward (2.23), which is the only stallion to arrive at the distinction of having 200 of his get obtain records of 2.30 or better.

The dam of Kingward was by the great show horse and sire King Rene. Kingward was bred by W. J. & W. H. Lewis, of Woodlake, Ky., breeders of the Champion three-beat trotting gelding, W. J. Lewis (2.06). Oakley Baron is standard and registered, No 12978. He is a handsome, seal-brown horse, of such bone and substance, with style and action, standing 15.5, and weighing 1175 pounds. He has recorded over 100 patrons the past season. He will impart substance and speed to his offspring and blood second to none of the good horses now in the domain of King Edward I.

Just a word as to Oakley Baron as a race-horse. The writer of this sketch saw him take his record, and it was in a seven-hundred race, which he won, when a big, growthy four-year-old, and over a half-mile track. Pitted against him was Estill Boy (2.16), rated a sure 2.10 trotter or better over a good mile track, and there was little
