MORNING STOCK LETTER

NEW YORK, May 25—The London market and prices are lower because of some disappointment concerning the modifications of the new tax bills submitted to Parliament yesterday.

Aluminum Ltd.—Canadian exports of Aluminum for first four months, virtually all from Aluminum Ltd. subsidiaries, \$2,900,000 up substantially from \$6,000,000 for same period in 1936 though shipping in early part of year normally inactive, further increase in earnings indicated for current year.

Car Loadings—Canadian car loadings for week ended May 15 were 10 per cent lower than previous week but were 4.2 per cent higher than corresponding week a year ago.

Asbestos—April exports of better grade asbestos were highest in the company's history. Increase over the preceding month was 31 per cent.

Iron and Steel—Production of steel ingots declined 3.4 per cent in April as compared with March but were 13.5 per cent higher than April 1936. Pig iron production was 4.1 per cent lower and 26.1 per cent higher than April 1936.

MARKET BULLETIN

NEW YORK, May 25—Extreme dullness prevailed in yesterday's market but little volume indications were present appeared to favor the upside movement.

Expenditures probably account for the bulk of the higher operating costs. The metal stocks act well and we feel that Anaconda, Kennecott and Phelps Dodge Corporation are likely to continue sensitive to the tone of the General Market and therefore among the more attractive issues for trading purposes.
