

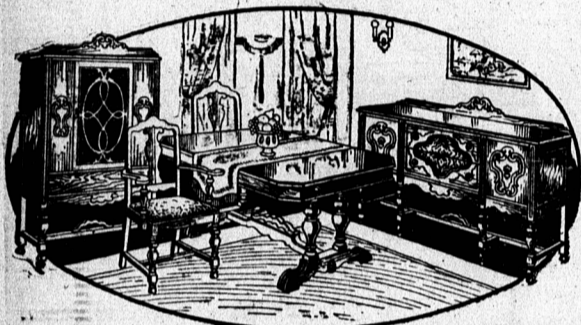

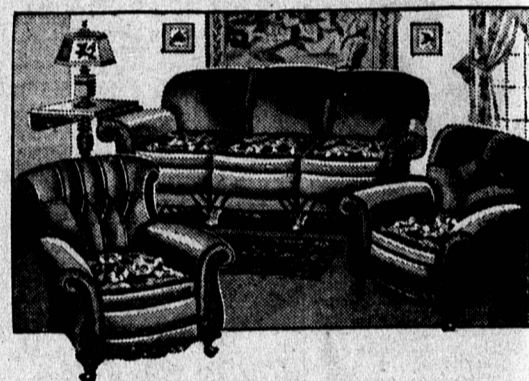

Canada In World's Skyways

C. H. Dickens, "Snow Eagle of the North."

EDMONTON, May 3—An aerial master, honored by his Majesty the King for daring in war and peace, Clennell H. "Punch" Dickens, O.B.E., D.F.C., one of Canada's most famous fliers, is known wherever aviators meet.
Small of stature, but steady of nerve, "Punch" Dickens has had many adventures over the bleak, snow-swept stretches of the Far North, pioneering aerial trials across the wilderness where he was the first to pilot a plane.
Since his early youth, when he

joined the daring band of youngsters who made up the Royal Canadian Flying Corps, "Punch" has known the thrills of the air, but today much of his time is given over to executive work in which he directs a corps of pilots in a network of aerial communication between the north country and the "outside."
Known to the Indians as "Snow Eagle," the Edmonton pilot-executive has thousands of miles of flight checked on his logs, ranging as high as 75,000 miles a year. All the north country knows him, from the trappers and hunters' cabins in Northern Ontario to the far Arctic.
Awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross as a war pilot, Dickens came back to Canada to enter commercial aviation, and to break the way for the regular services which today maintain scheduled times in the delivery of mail, passengers and supplies for the northern inhabitants.
Keen on the future development of aviation in Canada, he visualizes speedy, stratosphere ships, and larger planes carrying the commerce of the world to the far flung reaches of the Dominion. Quiet mannered as he sits behind his big oak desk in a downtown Edmonton office building the flier is reticent of his own famed exploits. But is always ready to pay tribute to his colleagues, and the little mentioned air engineers who are responsible for the maintenance of the planes and their operation.
Winner of the McKee Trophy, outstanding award in Canadian aviation, Dickens, who gained this coveted award in 1928 as he pioneered the way into the north, has known all the tragedies and adventures of flight. He has been the man at the controls in many dis-

tant journeys; has been lost from the world as he sought to aid fellow-fliers in distress, and has made many "mercy flights"—shown in the aviators' logs as "ambulance flights"—during his years in the north.
Parka-clad and fur helmeted, he has often speeded his snow-covered plane into the Edmonton Airport bringing a trapper, a miner or prospector sick or injured from the isolation of the north to medical and hospital care in Edmonton.
The "Snow Eagle" today is superintendent for the Mackenzie River district—embracing a territory thousands of miles in extent and the most hazardous "flying field" in the Dominion—of the Canada Airways Limited. From his desk here, he directs the daily work of ground crews and sky riders, but he, too, often soars northward, at the controls of his own ship.
Dickens was made an officer of the Order of the British Empire in King's honors Jan. 1, 1935.
