### WINTER FEEDING OF LAMBS.

A good ration consists of clover or alfalfa hay, two pounds, roots, two pounds and corn ensilage, two pounds. Should all of the above roughage not be available, a limited amount of grain mixture composed of equal parts of oats and bran should be added to keep the lambs growing steadily and in fair flesh. Lambs made over fat during the first winter will not attain the size necessary for the breeding of large market lambs.

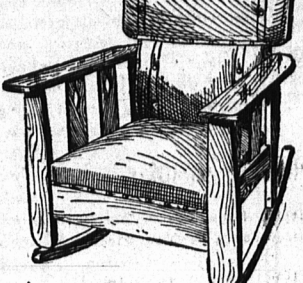
