S'ide Milkman Retires After 32 Years On Route

After thirty-two years of serving his customers in Summerside with a door-to-door delivery of fresh milk, Mr. George Harris, of Sherbrooke, has retired. On Wednesday he made his final delivery. Mr. Harris plans to devote all his time and energy in the future to looking after his large farm.

Not one milkman who was on the job when Mr. Harris commenced is in the business today and most of them have since passed on. On retiring, Mr. Harris said that the people of the town have always been his close friends and his relations with them were always most cordial.

Milk Run To Nfld. Operates Thrice Weekly

What is probably the longest milk run in the world, between the Ideal Dairy, Summerside and the U. S. Army Air base at Harmon Field, Newfoundland, is now operating three days a week instead of two as previously. Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday a U. S. Army transport plane drops down at the Summerside airport and picks up 2,000 pounds of pasteurized milk and a number of cases of eggs. This makes 8,000 pounds of milk a week, which is an increase of 2,000 pounds.

Arrangements for this extra amount were completed a week ago. Ideal Dairy is also putting up milk in one-quart paper containers for the wives and families of the men stationed at Harmon Field. This is the first time that milk has been put up in this manner in this Province.

Many expressions of satisfaction have been received from the officers at Harmon Field with regard to this service which they find to be economical and convenient. With the planes landing here regularly Summerside has become a bit of a jumping-off point for that base and on a number of occasions wives joining their husbands there have come to Summerside and waited to be picked up by the next plane. Many things besides milk and eggs are purchased. Recently three barrels of oysters were shipped and the amount of shopping done by the crews in the stores of the town is surprising.

OUTDOOR DRAMA. HAS POPULAR DOG STAR


