Taffeta of linen in bright greens and vivid reds are being used and the blouse is worn with a light colored skirt of serge, linen or one of the novelty colored cotton crepe, trimmed with bone buttons and having a striped cotton velvet collar and cuffs, in which there is a darker tone of the yellow, is being shown; it is one of the most effective blouses of this kind seen this season.

FRENCH ELECTIONS A TRIUMPH FOR BRIAND POLICY.

PARIS, April 28.—An examination of the completed returns in the general elections for the chamber of deputies shows that France wants neither revolution nor reaction. The new chamber will differ little in its composition from the one that preceded it.

The political leaders consider that the country has given a clear indication that it favored the programme of the Briandist federation. A large number of Cailleux radicals threw over the official programme of the party, and substituted many articles of the Brandists.

The principal interest centered in the country's verdict on the armament question, and the electorate accepted the additional military burden. Ex-President Barthou, who was responsible for the period of military service to three years, was re-elected by an overwhelming majority, as were also Louis L. Klotz, minister of the interior in the Barthou Cabinet, and Alexandre Millerand, ex-minister of war.

CONVICTED OF TWENTY OFFENCES.

MONCTON, April 30.—Legar R. Richard, has been convicted of 20 Scott Act violations and sentenced to fines and costs aggregating \$1065. Must spend five years in jail, three months for each offence. He says he cannot pay.
