CHRISTMAS Day was quiet in Summerside yesterday—the heavy rain which continued all day preventing the usual driving and visiting.

LAST week is admitted by those in a position to know, to have been the biggest business week in the town's history. The weather and roads were particularly favorable and town and country poured into the stores during the whole week.

THE Semi Annual examination of the Port Hill school took place last Friday and was attended by a very large number of parents and visitors not only from the district itself but from neighboring districts as well. Among those present were Hon. Sen. Yeo, Rev. J. Harper, D. C. Ramsay, Andrew Gillis, Wm. Montgomery and others. The examination was conducted by Mr. Simpson, Teacher, Lot 14 who took the later French and higher branches, Rev. Mr. Harper taking history, reading and other branches. The school room was handsomely decorated, with evergreens and appropriate mottoes. At the close commendatory remarks were made by a number of the visitors who spoke in the highest praise of the manner in which the school was conducted by the teacher, Mr. Edgar Brown.

Yesterday was the first Christmas day in the history of Summerside on which the harbor was open and the boat able to make her regular trips. The Northumberland went to Point du Chene as usual in the morning and returned on time in the evening. The occasion was marked in a very pleasing manner by the presentation to Capt. Cameron of an address signed by the business men of the town accompanied by a valuable gold headed cane. The presentation was made, immediately after the arrival of the Northumberland, in presence of a large number of ladies and gentlemen. 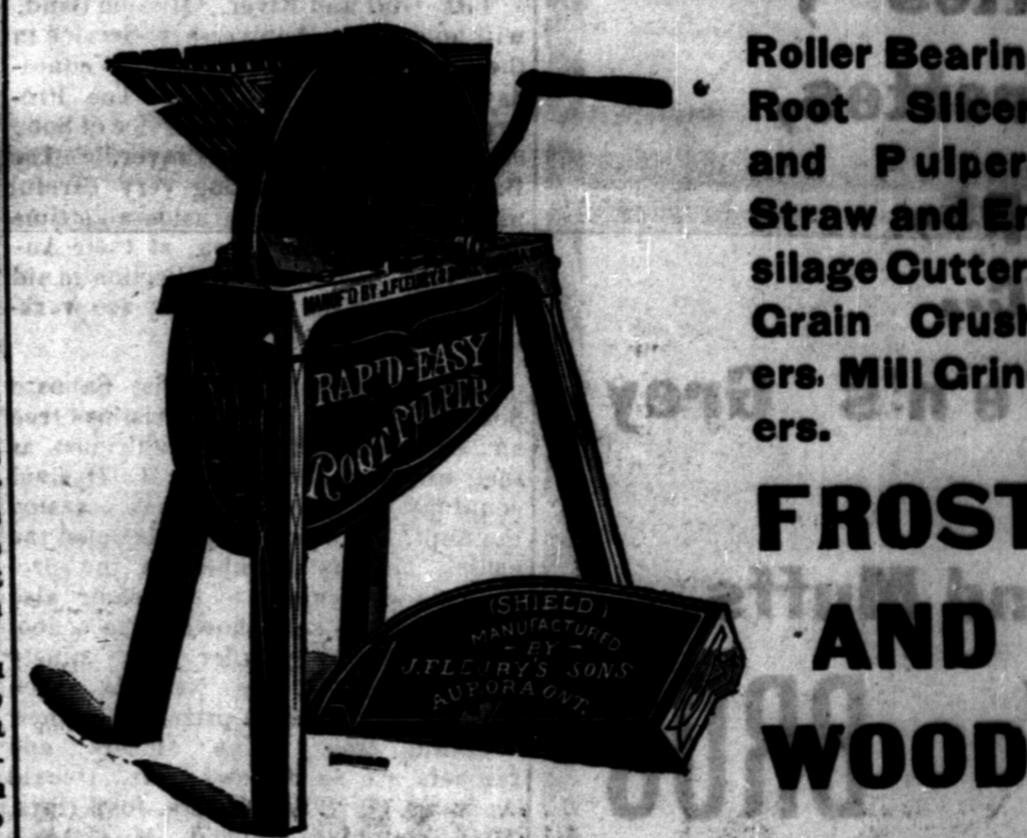
