## PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE

Questions Asked -- Information Brought  
Down -- And Bills Being Considered  
By The House In  
Committee

(Continued from yesterday's Guardian.)

Wednesday, March 11th, 1908.

HON. MR. HUGHES justified the stand taken by the Premier. It was not in the interests of the Province that such a statement would be liable to misconstruction should go out, showing only the state of the accounts at the end of December. The statement to the end of February 1908 gave a "proper" understanding of the situation of the Province.

MR. MATHIESON asked who was to be chairman of the Public Accounts Committee as he understood Captain Read had resigned owing to pressure of other business.

PREMIER HASZARD said that Mr. Richards would be the new chairman of the Committee, and the vacancy on the committee was filled by the appointment of Dr. Warburton.

House then went into Committee of the whole to pass a bill entitled "An Act to Amend an Act to Consolidate and Amend the several Acts incorporating the City of Charlottetown. This bill was to grant the City power to expend \$25,000 for permanent streets and sidewalks, and to issue debentures for same payable in 25 years bearing interest at 4 per cent.

The bill was amended to read that the debentures would bear interest not exceeding four and a half per cent, and was before the House until it adjourned at 6 o'clock.
