An extremely delicate problem of timing was involved in today's deal.

East dealer. Both sides vulnerable. North-South 60 on score.

The bidding:

East	South	West	North
1♦	1♥	Pass	2♥
2♦	2♥	Pass	3♥
4♦	4♥	Pass	Pass
Double	Redouble	Pass	Pass

West opened the diamond queen and continued that suit declarer ruffing with the heart king. The lead of a low heart to dummy disclosed the trump break, and South row led a club toward the K-Q. East ducked and the king, of course, held.

Declarer now went into a long huddle, and firmly emerged with the winning play. He led a low spade, away from the ace; West put up the jack in order to lead a trump but this did not disturb the declarer. He won in dummy an led another club. East went in with the ace and made a return that was as good as any, namely the club jack. Declarer's king won, and now a straight cross-ruff was sure to produce the balance of the tricks. After cashing the ace of spades, declarer could ruff two spades in dummy and could also ruff a diamond and a club in his own hand, with high trump.

Find War Material Hidden In Berlin

BERLIN, Aug. 1 (AP)—The American Military Government announced today it had discovered large quantities of war material, which apparently had been manufactured for an unidentified "foreign power," secreted in stockpiles in two German factories in the United States sector of Berlin.

IRON ICED TOGS FOR CRISPNESS

To put a finish as crisp as a lettuce leaf on freshly laundered cotton togs or neckwear pieces, sprinkle with warm water and store in the refrigerator for an hour before ironing.

This tip, which promises more uniform dampness and easier ironing, comes from home economists. They suggest more tricks to speed up work and reduce fatigue on summer washdays.

As important for fast, smooth ironing as the correct degree of iron heat is the proper dampness for clothes. Sprinkled clothes, not iced up before ironing, say experts, should stand for two or three hours so that moisture will penetrate fibers uniformly.

Conserve your energy by sitting down to iron and having clothes within easy reach of your hands. Put sprinkled clothes on one side, a rack or table for finished clothes on the other. If you iron on a padded table or at a wall-attached ironing board, an ordinary straight-back chair will give you comfortable support. A conventional folding ironing board may require a

higher chair. With this, a small footstool will keep the feet of the "little woman" from dangling in mid-air while she works.

If you stand up to your ironing see that the board is adjusted so that you can stand straight while working. Bending over the base is what puts misery in your back.
