### DOCTORS AND PATENT MEDICINES

In addressing the students of McGill a short time ago Earl Grey used plain words, first advising the boys to "step on" Montreal's Tammany and then entering upon a crusade—as the despatches put it—against patent medicines, especially of the class largely made up of whiskey and other intoxicating fluids.

His Lordship told of buying a bottle of a much advertised patent medicine and having it analysed, showing that it contained 40.5 of proof spirit. He proceeded: "I am of the opinion that laws should be made that it would be required to show what patent medicines contained. It should be set down that all drugs containing alcohol and narcotics, and other potent drugs, should have the percentages of these drugs printed on the labels of bottles. If not, the sheriff of the undertaker will mingle with that of the medical profession."

About the same time the annual convention of the Proprietary Articles Trade Association was held in Montreal. It was attended by one hundred persons representing larger and smaller manufacturers of patent medicines in Canada, and a slashing resolution aimed at the doctors who scorn patent medical preparations was passed. This resolution recommended the preparation and publication in the newspapers of a series of articles.

These articles are designed to fight the battle of the patent medicine people against the doctors, along the line that "the position assumed by the average physician as a public benefactor was absurd and untrue. Their whole mission in life, said the resolution, was collecting coin, the same as any other business. There are good and bad doctors as there are good and bad patent medicines. The bad patent medicine was, however, soon discovered and put away, while the

doctor of the poor class kept on putting away his patients until at last he was put away himself."

His Excellency is quite right in denouncing the whiskey compounds sold as medicines, and in recommending legislation that will compel the manufacturers to make clear to their customers precisely what they are buying. And we think the patent medicine men are imprudent to challenge any battle with the doctors. No doubt there are good as well as bad proprietary preparations, but it will be a cold day for them all, or for the most of them if the doctors should unite to discredit them.

### PROVINCIAL SUBSIDIES.

The matter of increased provincial subsidies will not down. When the Provinces first made the surrender of their principal sources of revenue to the federal authority in 1867 the enormous increase of federal taxation and revenue was not dreamed of. The federal revenue at first was but \$13,000,000. It has been increased to about six times that figure. It is absurd and unjust that provincial subsidies should remain practically the same as they were at the beginning. The federal authority must in the end be forced to submit to a more equitable division.

In this connection a recent outspoken deliverance of Premier Gouin has awakened echoes from the Atlantic to the Pacific. Among other things he said: "If it takes too long to solve, I predict that you will see this problem become the point of departure for a sure evolution in the political parties in this Province. I do not, in fact, fear to be the first in proclaiming it." He says the question must be settled on the line of the provincial claims, if not by the present Administration, then by one of those coming after it.

Prince County under prohibition does not want a bonded liquor warehouse, and we hope to see the warehouse kept in King's County by a notorious violator of the law swept out of existence.

Archbishop Bruchesi has issued a pastoral prohibiting the attendance of the faithful at horse races, ball games, theatricals, concerts, political meetings and excursions when held on Sunday. This may do much to check the growing profanation of the day of rest in the Canadian metropolis. Archbishop Bruchesi's energetic and successful efforts to promote temperance are also worthy of all commendation.

The manner in which the License Law is persistently evaded and violated in St. John has led the temperance people to consider the propriety of calling for a vote on the Scott Act. That City has already twice voted on petitions to bring in the Scott Act with the result of pretty close voting in both cases. In 1882 the vote stood 1074 for and 1076 against the Act and in 1886 there were 1610 votes for and 1087 votes against the Act. If the prohibition sentiment has made any considerable advance in St. John as it undoubtedly has in other parts of Canada, there ought now to be a majority there favorable to the suppression of the liquor traffic.
