IN ENGLISH POLITICS. LONDON, Jan. 27—The combined strength of the Liberal, Labor and Nationalist coalition has now reached 345, or more than half the members of the House of Commons. The Conservative Government is, therefore, out of the question; and the only point still undecided is the exact strength of the coalition majority. As an independent Liberal majority is equally out of the question, only a short life can be predicted for the incoming Government, and both the Liberal and Unionist parties are looking into the far distant future, when the conflict at the polling booths will be renewed. Parties now stand: Liberals, 233; Laborites, 38; Nationalists, 74; Conservatives, 255. Net gains of Conservatives, 98; yet to be called 70.
