In old England they had many dishes which we seldom hear of now. There was 'frumenty', a dish made of wheat which is still sometimes served in Yorkshire, ale posset, Shropshire 'twigs', and carrot wavy buns dipped in ale. Yule doughs or 'dows' were eaten everywhere, and in Coventry they made their famous Godeake. Tansy, too, was a favorite dish. This was made with eggs and cream, flavored with the juice of tansy, an extremely bitter, aromatic herb. In addition there was Christmas 'connynges' in gravy, and a host of dishes that have since died out.
