Times Denounces Proposed Import of Soviet Timber

LONDON, Jan. 22.—(Canadian Press Cable) Reuters News Agency today said it understood Rt. Hon. J. H. Thomas, Secretary of State for the Dominions, had replied to representations by Hon. G. Howard Ferguson, Canadian High Commissioner to Great Britain, respecting reported proposals on the part of British timber importers to bring in large shipments of Russian timber. No definite information was available concerning the proposed importations, Reuters said.

Japan Professes Only Desire Is To Safeguard Peace

TOKYO, Jan. 21.—(A.P.)—Premier Tsuboyoshi Inukai told the Japanese Diet, which reconvened yesterday that Japan had no territorial designs on Manchuria. A brief life was indicated for Parliament, with an Imperial decree dissolving the Diet expected late in the afternoon. Finance Minister Takahashi attacked the financial and economic policy of former Premier Wakatsuki's government, attributing the present depression to former Minister of Finance Inoue's removal of the embargo on gold.

Equitable Payment Of Relief Monies Still A Problem

TORONTO, Ont., Jan. 22.—(By The Canadian Press)—Mrs. James Cotton, Toronto social service worker, tonight said Prime Minister R. B. Bennett had assured her during the course of a brief informal interview here that he would call the attention of the Provinces to the possibility of women suffering under present economic conditions in the hope they would see to it women received an equitable amount of relief monies to care for them. Mrs. Cotton said she drew the attention of the Prime Minister to the fact that, though married men with children received first consideration in the distribution of relief, there was no provision for unmarried men with mothers and sisters dependent upon their earnings.
