By James W. Barton, M.D. KEEPING AHEAD OF TUBERCULOSIS Some recent statistics regarding tuberculosis, or "consumption" as it was formerly called, should be of great interest to all of us.

Samuel Gompers, the veteran President of the American Federation of Labor, has had a remarkable record.

He was born in London, England, January 29, 1850. When he was 13 years old he came over to the United States, became a cigar maker and while yet in his teens entered upon his career of labor reform, in which he has since become famous.

With its dependents the American Federation of Labor is said to represent over three times the actual number of its membership, or anywhere from 13 to 15 millions of people.
