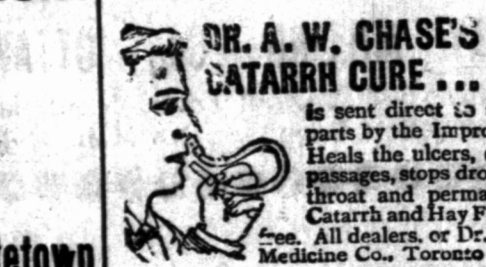

The treasury department alone owns 7000 good linen towels, each red-bordered and with the calligraphic "U. S." in the centre, and uses upward of 2000 every day. All these mountains of spoiled linens are given out by contract to certain well known laundries, who have grown rich on what seems a very small price (35 cents per 100 towels) are mostly renovated by the good old-fashioned method of wash tubs and elbow grease, by colored women of the District in their shanty homes, at a much less price than the contractor receives for the finished work.
