DDT NOT A REPELLENT

The chemical DDT, though extremely effective in killing many kinds of insects, is not itself a repellent and will not keep away flies, mosquitoes and other pests. Actually this is an advantage, as insects are not discouraged from coming into contact with the chemical and receiving a lethal dose. DDT does not kill insect eggs, though solvents used in

some sprays containing it may do so, but because of the length of time DDT remains active after application, young larvae or nymphs are likely to be killed when they hatch from the eggs and come in contact with the residue of the chemical.

CHURCH OF SCOTLAND PULPIT

"And behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus. He shall be great and shall be called the Son of the Highest, and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David; and he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end." (Luke 1:31-33). This prophecy of the angel Gabriel to Mary formed the subject of the discourse by Rev. Horace P. MacBrien, preached in the Church of Scotland on December 22. Jesus, the seed of the woman, was virgin-born, Isaiah foretold his birth thus: "Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (God with us)". Jeremiah said: "For the Lord hath created a new thing in the earth, a woman shall compass a man".

"The word became flesh in the fulness of the times when God sent forth His son, made of a woman... to redeem those that were under the law". His sacred name, Jesus, means "Jehovah the Saviour". He is Jehovah, the Lord God Almighty. He is the Son of God, the Messiah, the suffering servant. He is the bruiser of the serpent who deceived our first parents in Eden, and who was put down only by Christ's redemptive work of atonement for sin. He came primarily "to seek and to save that which was lost"; hence He is the Saviour. He said: "I came not to judge the world, but to save the world" (John 12:47). On the cross His adversaries taunted Him: "Save thyself and come down from the cross". He delivered up Himself to death in order that He might save a lost and wicked world. "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners". Thus the work of redemption was accomplished.

He is great because of the cross. "God hath highly exalted him, and given him a name above every name: that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow" (Philippians 2: 9-10). He is crowned with glory and honour, "because of the suffering of death." He is set down with His Father on His throne expecting until His enemies be made His foot-stool. He is the high-priest and advocate for all believers.

He will take the throne of His father David when He returns to earth, corporally and visibly, to rule and to reign. His first coming was in humility. His second will be in power and glory. As the prospect which pertained to His first advent were all fulfilled to the letter, so will those that refer to His second coming be similarly accomplished. Isaiah said: "Of the increase of his government and with justice from henceforth even forever." (Isaiah 9: 6-7). This will be-

gin with the millennial rule, and go on forever in the heaven and new earth. "I am the root and offspring of David, the bright and morning star. And the spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. Even so, come, Lord Jesus". (Revelation 22: 16, 17, 20).

The Dessert Is Ready

Preparations for the Christmas or New Years dinners require so much extra time that it often comes as a shock that the family cannot subsist on anticipation or retrospect of the gala but demand three good meals every day.

There are some desserts with a holiday air which give a glamorous touch to an otherwise plain meal. The home economists of the Consumer Section, Dominion Department of Agriculture suggest gelatine desserts which may be made ahead of time as excellent for use during holiday week. Apple desserts, quickly made and set aside to cool are also just the thing for such meals. With one or more of these ready in the refrigerator it takes only a little while to heat soup, cut cold meat or make a salad for a meal that seems to be rather special.

Any of the gelatine desserts may be made in double quantity. They are so good that no one will mind having them appear a second time. The Chocolate Plum Pudding is equally good for the festive dinner or everyday meal.

Holiday Apples

½ cup sugar
 1 cup water
 1 cup cranberries
 8 apples
 Bring sugar and water to boil. Add cranberries. Simmer 5 minutes.

Wash, peel and core apples and arrange in baking dish, pour cranberry mixture over apples. Bake in a moderate oven, 350° F., until tender, 20 -- 25 minutes, basting occasionally during cooking. Serve hot or cold. Six servings.

Spanish Mould

1 jelly roll
 2 teaspoons gelatine
 2 cups milk
 2 eggs, separated
 Pinch of salt
 ¼ cup sugar
 ¼ teaspoon vanilla

Soak gelatine in ¼ cup of milk. Scald the rest of the milk. Beat egg yolks with sugar and salt, add the scalded milk slowly, return to double boiler and cook, stirring constantly until the mixture coats the spoon. Dissolve gelatine in the hot mixture. Cool and add flavoring. Cut jelly roll in ¼ inch slices and use to line a mould. When gelatine mixture is partly set, beat in the stiffly beaten egg whites and pour into the lined mould. Chill until set. Six to eight servings.

 1 tablespoon gelatine
 ¼ cup cold water

1 ½ squares (1 1/2 ozs.) unsweetened chocolate
 2 cups milk
 ½ cup sugar
 ¼ teaspoon vanilla
 1 cup raisins
 ½ cup chopped dates
 ¼ cup currants
 ¼ cup chopped nuts
 Pinch of salt

Soak gelatine in cold water.

Melt chocolate in top of double boiler and add milk. When milk reaches scalding point, add sugar and soaked gelatine. Remove from heat and cool. When mixture begins to thicken, add vanilla, fruits and nuts. Turn into individual moulds or in 1 large mould rinsed with cold water and chill. Unmould on serving dish. Garnish with sweetened whipped cream, if desired. For a spicy flavour 1/2

teaspoon cinnamon may be added, if desired. Six servings.

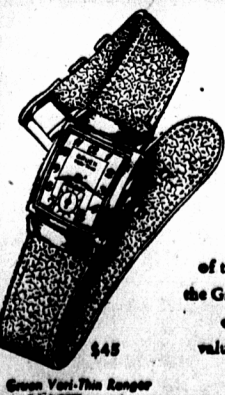
"BURY ME SUNDAY"

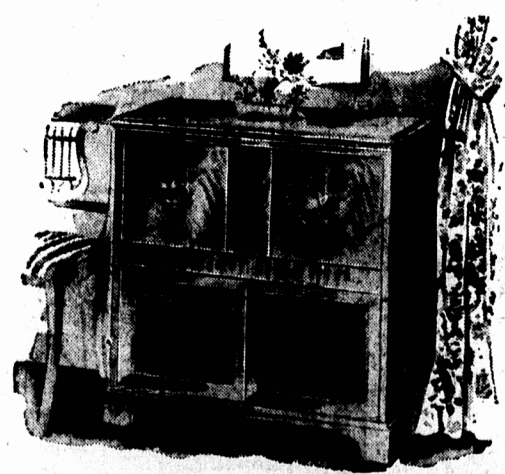
