MR. ROOSEVELT ON CHARACTER

SAO, PAULO, Oct. 30, (Special)—What constitutes character? Mr. Theodore Roosevelt addressed himself in this question in a speech on "Character and Civilization," delivered in the government university here.

"The sum of those qualities, distinct from the purely intelligent qualities, which are essential to moral efficiency," was Mr. Roosevelt's definition of character. "Resolution, courage, energy, power and self-control combined with fearlessness in taking the initiative and assuming responsibility; a just regard for the rights of others, together with unflinching determination to succeed, no matter what obstacles and barriers have to be heaved down. These, is, moreover, one quality too often wholly lacking in men of high intellectual ability, without which real character cannot exist—namely, the fundamental gift of common sense."

Character, Mr. Roosevelt said, must ever outrank genius and intellect. Intellect was a useful servant, but an evil master unless itself mastered by character. "This was true of individuals and in larger sense true of nations. American republics, north and south, had shown in the past, again and again, a curious forgetfulness of this precept. A republic could prosper although the average man were not brilliant; a republic could not prosper if its average man became infirm of mind and soul, if he feared hard labor, if he sought to rise by ways that represent wrong to his weaker brethren.

History had written large the truth that only the nation with character endured, Mr. Roosevelt continued. When moral fibre became soft, when the leaders led lives of self-indulgence and viciousness, the nation decayed and declined.

KRUPPS BRIBERY SCANDAL IN COURT

BERLIN, Oct. 30, (Special)—The scandal connected with the activities of Herr Maximilian Brandt in bribing officers of the German army to disclose details of pending armament contracts to him as the agent for Krupp's armament works threatened to come to light at the time of the great national celebration of Krupp's secretary, in August, 1912, according to the chairman of the Krupp directorate, who testified at the resumption of the trial today.

He said Herr Brandt then expressed anxiety as to the consequences of his method of collecting information, and the directorate, realizing that the exposure of the character of Herr Brandt's intercourse with military officials might result in public scandal, determined to transfer him. Before this was done, however, the firm had been forced to dismiss Herr von Metzzen, its chief Berlin representative, who was aware of the incriminating character of Herr Brandt's work and possessed copies of his secret reports. This precipitated the dreaded exposure.

The accused before the court are Herr Otto Eccius and Herr Maximilian Brandt, both of whom are charged with bribery. Several army officers and ordnance department clerks were sentenced by court-martial on August 5 to terms of imprisonment for accepting bribes from them. As the military court could not deal with civilian prisoners they were brought before the criminal court in Berlin.

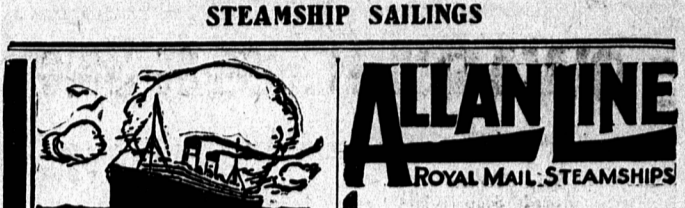
