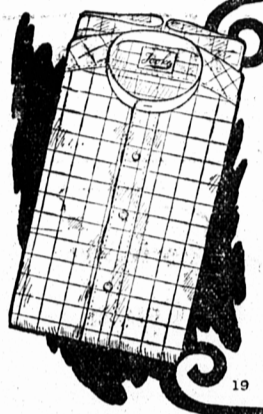

HOTEL MAN TO EVELYN THAW

Files Answer In Suit For \$25,000 Damages For Alleged Illegal Ejectment.

NEW YORK, June 7. — James B. Regan, manager of the Knickerbocker Hotel, has filed his answer to Evelyn Thaw's suit to recover \$25,000 damages, based upon the fact that she was ordered out of the Knickerbocker where she had gone with E. R. Thomas, on March 3rd.

He admits that he requested Thomas to leave with Mrs. Thaw. His answer in justification recites the facts in the prosecution of Harry K. Thaw for the murder of Stanford White, refers to the testimony given by Mrs. Thaw.

"That as a result of the testimony of the plaintiff she had gained great notoriety and much doubt existed as to the truth of her testimony, which made her presence most objectionable in the Hotel Knickerbocker, and objectionable to the patrons, customers and guests, and detrimental to the business and interests of this defendant."

"That the plaintiff at the times mentioned in said complaint, was accompanied and escorted to the grill room by one E. R. Thomas, a married man."

"That previous thereto and since the incarceration of Harry K. Thaw in the asylum the said Thomas had accompanied and escorted plaintiff to various restaurants and public places unaccompanied by his wife, as a result causing much public comment and scandal."

MONCTON, June 7. — Fred Patterson, aged seventeen years, was shot in the leg yesterday evening by a man who was firing at the former's dog.

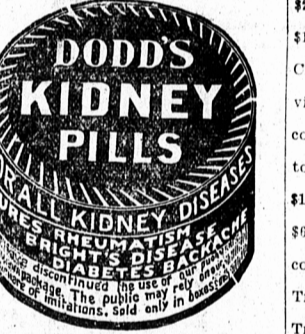

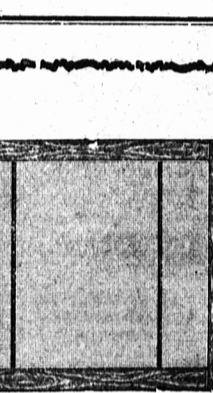
