C. N. R. OFFICIAL DIES OF SCARLET FEVER. MONTON, N. B., Feb. 7.—Telegraphic advice has been received by officials of the colonization department of the Canadian National Railway of the death in Winnipeg of Mr. F. C. Biette, for eight years a prominent official of the Colonization department and who was recently transferred to the Peace River District to have charge of the railway's colonization work in that area.

He spent some some years at headquarters at Montreal and four years ago he was appointed superintendent of land settlement for the railway in the Maritimes with headquarters at Moncton. Here he did notable work in connection with placement of new settlers on farms in the Maritimes, and in the handling of a large number of newcomers for farm employment. He was one of the most familiar figures in the Maritimes, where he enjoyed an immense popularity. He was chosen some years ago to accompany Rt. Hon. Margaret Bondfield, now a member of the British Cabinet on her trip through Canada and in 1928 also accompanied Lord Lovat on his tour of the Dominion in behalf of the British overseas settlement committee.

NEWS OF BR. BIETTE'S DEATH came as a shock to his host of friends through out Eastern Canada, where he had been widely known in his colonization work. Born at Woodstock, Ont., 39 years ago he received his early education there and for a time, as a young man, was employed with the Ontario Hydro Electric Commission on construction work. During the war he joined the Canadian Flying Corps and saw service at the front as a pilot, being wounded in action. On his return from the war, and after a short period in commercial work, he joined the Canadian Northern Railway, natural resources department.
