The Supreme Court was engaged yesterday with the case of McQuaid vs. Hennessy, Johnston, K. C., and Duffy for plaintiff and Gaudet for defendant. Owing to the absence of a jurymen, the case was adjourned until the afternoon. The juror was again absent, the Chief Justice informing the Court that he had a letter from a doctor stating that the juror was suffering from acute indigestion. His Lordship remarked that he had been informed during recess that the cause of this juror's absence was intoxication and he thereupon discharged the juror, expressing regret that such a course was necessary. A new jury was empanelled and the case was proceeded with. The Court adjourned at 4.50 the same case to be resumed this morning.

On Monday afternoon, January 15th after a short family service at the house, the remains were removed to the Presbyterian church. The church, which was filled with friends and relatives, was draped in black. After the service conducted by Rev. Mr. Wright, assisted by Rev. Mr. Stewart, the remains, followed by a great number of carriages, were conveyed to their last resting place in the Lower Montague cemetery. The many beautiful flowers testified, in a small degree, to the respect in which Mrs. Younker was held. "Life is a vapor that appeareth for a little time and then vanisheth away" was strikingly exemplified in the sad message which was wired on Dec. 20th from Toronto to Mr. and Mrs. Alexander Buntain, New London, that their son Fulton Buntain, had died on that day in the Hospital in this City. Shortly before his death he was appointed Auditor for the Co. by the late Mr. R. P. Fyfe, Boston, and a brother Daniel of Saskatchewan, were present at the burial.
