FORWARD MOVE BY NOVA SCOTIA.

TORONTO, August 15.—Professor Howard Murray, of the chair of classics in Dalhousie university, and Mr. Kempton, of the Nova Scotia advisory board of education, arrived in Toronto to-day to enquire into the school book situation. They were received at the education department by Dr Colquhoun, acting minister of education, who introduced them to Dr Goggit, supervising editor of the new Ontario public school readers and text books.

The maritime provinces have taken a keen interest in the system in vogue in this province, whereby the public school pupil may obtain his books at a minimum figure, and it is not improbable that the example of the Prince Edward Island government a couple of weeks ago in adopting Ontario readers and ordering the required supply from local publishers, may be followed by the Nova Scotian department of education. Professor Murray and Mr Kempton will remain in Toronto for a week.

MISSIONARIES ARE SAFE.

TORONTO, August 15.—Reassurance has come from Japan regarding the safety of the Canadian missionaries working in the neighborhood of district wiped out. The Methodist mission board, who have the largest number of workers in the Japanese field, received a cable to-day supplementing the one sent the other day, notifying the board of the floods, stating that the Canadians are all safe. It appears that the safety of the missionaries and their families was due to the fact that this is holiday season, and they had all removed from the affected area to a summer resort called Krauzawa, from which place the cable was dispatched. A welcome cable was sent by Rev Dr D. R. McKenzie and all inquiring friends and relatives of the missionaries are being acquainted with news.

A LOVING ONE DEPARTED.

An esteemed and respected resident of Montague in the person of the late Duncan Dewar, passed peacefully away of paralysis at the residence of his brother-in-law Capt John T. Dewar on Monday the 18th July 1916, at the age of sixty years.

DOG DISCOVERS BODY OF MURDERED MISTRESS.

LANCASTER, Cal., Aug. 15.—In a shallow grave sunk in the sand of her front yard, a pet dog has uncovered the body of Mrs Frieda Schultze Castine, a wealthy ranch owner.

Murder, with robbery as the probable motive, is suspected and telegrams have been sent to ports and border cities between Galveston and San Francisco to arrest the woman's brother-in-law, Otto Schultze, who left here Saturday, after saying he was bound for Germany. Mrs Castine was last seen Friday, when she came here from her ranch, four miles east, to receive a remittance of \$6,000 from relatives in San Francisco.

Investigations tend to show that the woman was attacked as she drove into her yard, and was thrown into the shallow hole while yet alive.

An examination by an autopsy surgeon, disclosed the presence of sand in the lungs and bronchial tubes, drawn there by victim's dying gasps.

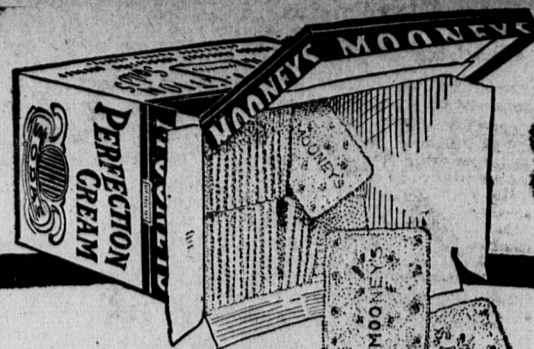
