

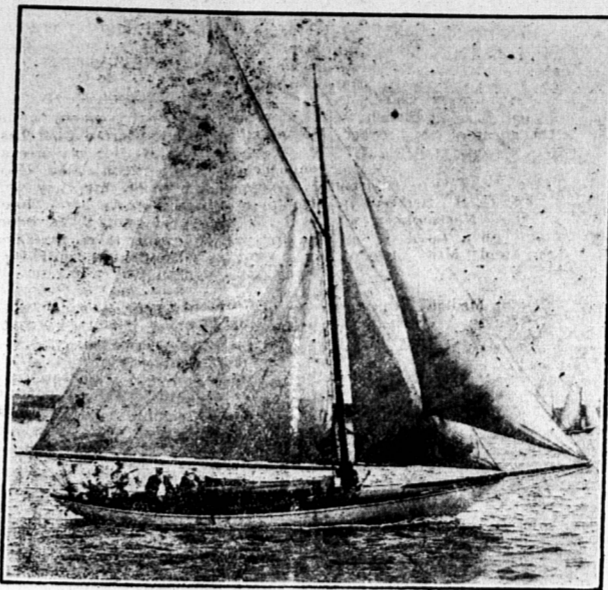

Commodore Rogers has done much throughout with a luxuriousness that is calculated to make anyone think that yachting must be an enjoyable occupation. The Charlotte is a handsome sloop, slightly under 40 feet in length, and is shown in the accompanying illustration. There are also owned in Charlottetown several other sloops, the Dreadnaught, Hawatha, Wanderer, Micmac, Vinco, etc., all of which are to be reckoned on in a race, and some remarkably fast lobster boats, notably the Hazel M. which can show her heels to most competitors. There is pleasure to no end in beautiful Charlottetown harbor for anyone who owns a boat. Within easy access of the city are beauty spots along the shore such as cannot be surpassed in Canada, fishing is not hard to find, and the delight of sailing swiftly along while the landscapes unfold with panoramic regularity may always be varied by landing in any place which looks particularly inviting and enjoying a picnic on shore. There have been many pleasant parties held in this manner. What would probably tend to organize the Charlottetown Yachting Club, electing Geo. J. THE GREAT EVENT OF THE YEAR.

Nova Scotia Exhibition to be held at Halifax on September 2nd to 10—Fine Show and Splendid Attractions are promised.

The announcement of the dates and of some of the features of the Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition is made in this week. The date of the big show is nearly a month earlier than last year—September 2nd to 10th. This season has been chosen to give visitors more pleasant weather during their sojourn at the capital, and it is hoped and believed by the management that the advanced condition of crops, and the relatively later date of entries, will make it possible to have a show of fruits and vegetables on a par with exhibitions of previous years held at later dates. The prize list for live stock has been increased over previous years by the addition of new sections. The list of entries of manufacturers is larger than usual. There will be horse races attracting the finest fields in the Maritime Provinces, on seven days, beginning with the opening and ending with the last day of the Fair. The purses aggregate \$6,000. The special attractions will be on a scale of special magnificence. They consist of seven or eight acts carefully selected by the Management. 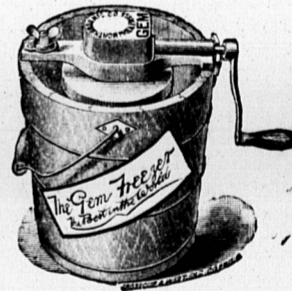
