### ADOPTION SECRETY FOILS BLACKMAILER

LONDON, Jan. 18—(Reuters)—Persons who adopt children in Britain will no longer be able to be squeezed by the blackmailer for hush money. The adopters are now protected by new rules which came into force Jan. 1 and which enable them to keep their identities secret. Persons who adopt a child in future will be given a number which will be used in court hearings, thus foiling blackmailers who in the past have extracted hush money from a couple by threatening to tell their adopted child who its real parents are. In the past it was only possible to obtain secrecy by applying to High Court judge and many couples could not afford this. Among other steps to ensure secrecy laid down in the new rules, issued by the British Lord Chancellor, Lord Jowitt, are: Anyone wishing to adopt a child need not be seen in court by the mother; applications for an adoption order are to be heard in camera; all documents must be confidential; guardians are ordered to maintain secrecy.

### OVERCAME PREJUDICE MAORI WOMAN ELECTED

AUCKLAND, N. Z., Jan. 16—(CP)—The first Maori woman to become a member of New Zealand's parliament is a widow with six children. She is Mrs. Iriaka Matu Ratana, who overcame the objections of Maori men that woman's place was in the home to win the Western Maori seat held by her late husband, Mr. Ratana, a Labor Party member. Mrs. Ratana was the official Labor candidate in the Dominion general election last Nov. 20. Mr. Ratana was a son of Wiremu Ratana, a Maori prophet who founded the Ratana Church. By allying itself with the Ratana movement, which has a large number of adherents, the Labor party has held a firm grip in the Western Maori seat. The recent election was the first in which a Maori woman stood for parliament. Mrs. Ratana won out over a second woman candidate, Mrs. K. Nutana, and eight men candidates. Mrs. Ratana, in her early 40s, is an accomplished musician who made a world tour with a concert party formed by the Ratana movement.
