BOSTON BULLDOG A BANK ROBBER ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., Feb. 7.—Muggins, a Boston bulldog owned by R. F. WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 9.—Claims were made today by the Taft managers that the fight for the renomination of the President is already won. After a conference between Senator Crane of Massachusetts, Senator Penrose of Pennsylvania and Secretary Hills, a statement was authorized that Taft would have in the Chicago convention 780 votes as the matter now stands. They concede only about 300 votes to the opposition. The whole list of States was canvassed by the two Senators and the secretary and they are now convinced that the opposition cannot possibly prevent the nomination of the President on the first ballot. 100,000 TROOPS FOR TEXAS SOON. SAN ANTONIO, Feb. 9.—Plans for the accommodation of at least 100,000 troops at points in the State are being perfected in Texas. No official order has been received, but preparations are practically complete. The question of the rights and duties of paternity are severe in comparison with the lax laws of a year ago, when an unfortunate child-mother and her baby could be deserted with impunity by her seducer. 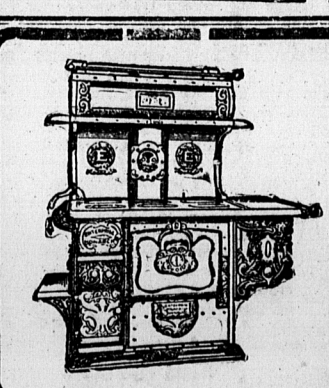

The first section deals with annuities, and shows that on March 31 last, 1,709 were in force, 1,025 males and 684 females; payable to last survivor, 19. In bounties, payments were as follows in the last fiscal year: Pig iron, \$261,434; steel, \$350,450; manufactures of steel, \$526,858; lead, \$248,535; manilla fibre, \$49,784; crude petroleum, \$160,596. The total was \$1,597,668. The report devotes twenty pages to figures showing imports, exports and manufacturers of Canada since. In that respect it is a compilation of the monthly reports from year to year. The figures for the last fiscal year are given out and published prior to the printing of the report.
