**A Harvester's Diary**

(Continued)

Alberta, August 28th, 1918.

We did not succeed in finding a sufficient quantity of hay in one place, combined with a good water supply, to warrant moving the cattle north. We had much ground to cut over at home and to supplement this my employer joined forces with another man to cut hay on a certain school section four miles distant. A number of persons had applied for permits to cut hay on this school section. They did not wait for official papers to arrive but started in making hay, so interests were bound to clash.

Much violent language was used on several occasions and once two of the disputants came to blows. A man who thought he had sole right to cut came mounted to drive us off but a hot-headed haysmacker in our faction used a hammer on him with telling effect. His horse reared throwing him off and then ran away. The man who wielded the hammer was reinforced by the man on the rake so the other chap was obliged to make a hasty retreat on shank's mare.

I have been cutting prairie hay with a mowing machine for the past three weeks. It has to be very dry to cut well and even then we used four sharp knives each day. The hay is not loaded on wagons but is drawn to the stacks from the windrow with a "bucker" or sweep 16 feet long which is handled by six horses, three hitched to each end. When the stack is reached a team is driven along each side and the hay is run up a chute ten or twelve feet high and falls over the upper end on to the stack. When a section of stack is built high enough the chute is drawn ahead and another piece started, thus stacks are built a great length. This year hay was raked and stacked as fast as it was cut. It is withered looking stuff but is nutritious.
