Upward Trend Of Stock Market Prices Continues

NEW YORK, March 6 - (AP) - The stock market took the largest stride ahead last week since the first week of the year. More than \$1,000,000,000 was added to the quoted value of all stocks listed on the stock exchange. But the volume of trading added up to one of the smallest figures in months. In two hours of trading Saturday the general price level managed one of the year's sharpest advances. Gains of fractions to more than a point were posted by U. S. Steel, Bethlehem Steel, American Telephone, Santa Fe, Union Pacific, Standard Oil (NJ), U. S. Rubber, American Can, General Electric, and Eastman Kodak.

At Toronto TORONTO, March 6 - (CP) - Prices finished on the upturn Saturday on the Toronto Stock Exchange. Turnover was 353,000 shares for the two-hour session. Lake Dufault Mines Ltd., holding company with base metal interests in Northern Quebec, was the market feature, up 19 cents at \$1.30 on 29,000-share turnover. Three other holding companies, Froebisher, Nipissing and Ventures each gained five cents. The base metal list picked up towards the close after general weakness. Waite Amulet ended up 1-8. Nickel lost 1-8. Western oils were mixed, Calgary and Edmonton added 20 cents. Golds were lightly traded. More active juniors were Bigdow, Down 1; Wiltsey Coghlan up 1-4; Louvich unchanged; and American Yellowknife up 1. Both Eldona and Eldona Rights were unchanged, the latter at 1-4 after reaching 1-2. The exchange's index showed gold up .71 at 92.81; base metals down .08 at 96.44; western oils up 19 at 49.88.

At Montreal MONTREAL, March 5 - (CP) - Securities staged a modest rally from early fractional losses in dull dealings at the close of the Montreal stock exchange and curb market Saturday session. Firming tendencies also were noted in fairly active mining sales during the two-hour week-end session. Senior oils were most active and brightened, featuring an otherwise steady market. Metals, beverages and utilities were quiet and generally moved slowly in either directions. Papers were slightly improved in a broad list. Ahead about 1-4 each were Abitibi, Common and Preferred, Bathurst, Fraser, International Paper, St. Lawrence, Corporation and Consolidated Paper. Price changes hands on odd lots at 50-1-2, up a full point from Friday's close. B. A. Oil was up 3-8 at 22 1-2. Imperial Oil, on a turnover of 3,680 shares, gained 1-2 at 18 1-2 and McColl on a total of 2,380 shares traded, added 1-2 at 13 1-2. International Petroleum was 1-4 improved at 9 1-4. In Western Oils, Anglo-Canadian was up 10 cents at \$4.45, Calgary and Edmonton 10 at \$4.30, Gaspé Mine at \$1.45 and Home Oil 1-4 at 11 1-2.

Going To Australia On Exchange Basis

(By The Canadian Press) OTTAWA, March 5 - Maj. E. W. H. Berwick, 40, of Calgary, has been promoted acting lieutenant-colonel and selected for attachment to the Australian military forces on an exchange basis, army headquarters announced today. Maj. Berwick has been second in command of the 2nd Armored Regiment (Lord Strathcona's Horse) at Calgary. Coming to Canada in exchange is Lt.-Col. H. G. Bates of the Australian army, who will be attached to army headquarters in the directorate of military training. Col. Bates is expected to arrive at Halifax March 11.
