TALES TOLD BY MEN ON THE FIRING LINE

BRITISH DOGGEDNESS IN A TRYING MARCH.

Some interesting incidents and experiences of a march by the British towards Bagdad were described in letters written to an officer, who has since been killed in the fighting at Ctesiphon before the retirement of the British force to Kuzel-Amanu. Appended are extracts from the letters, which have appeared in the London Times. Writing to his father from the Aiyile, the officer stated:

You won't find the above place on your map, but it is 45 miles from Bagdad by road and over 100 by river. I reached here just ten days ago from Kut, after the 61st and 62nd hours—no bad going for heavily equipped men in a temperature of over 100 deg. F. I. was in command of the column—a small one; half a Battery R.H.A., one squadron cavalry, one double company, and pack wireless.

We had a small scrap when we were near Kut, and as the report came in that our scouts were being fired on and were held up, I experienced very mixed feelings—(a) Here's a chance; do well and you're made; and (b) You've quite a lot of lives in your charge. Luckily I had only one course, and that was to push on and get through. So that there was no weighty decision to be made, and only the tactical disposition of the troops to be considered.

Luckily (or unluckily) the enemy were a rading party, but a few truculent Arabs whom a couple of shells and a little long range fire soon dispersed to the four winds, and we resumed our march unmolested—to the great relief of the Division, with whom I had been in communication by wireless.

At present we are standing fast, indulging in hourly skirmishing—in which the cavalry and R.H.A. get most of the fun, and digging for water. The Turks are perfectly visible and audible four miles away doing likewise, and the result of their clearing their front raises a pillar of smoke by day and of flames by night. An occasional shell buzzes overhead or falls with a plump in front, but so far they have done no harm at all. In the meantime we preserve a policy of grim silence, except when our aeroplane bomb them to assist reconnaissance, in precisely the same spirit as a boy heaves a brick at a wasp's nest, to find if it's occupied.

All we know at present is that their position is not nearly so strong, nor so well fortified, as we were told before. Kut, but that they have received reinforcements to the tune of several thousand. Two thousand of their reinforcements, however, do not equal 1,000 of ours, and we shall shortly be heavily buoyed up by the arrival of more from India who have been training for that purpose.

One curious thing we have noted. In all our captures up here, amounting in all to some 5,000-6,000, we have never captured a man who had been previously wounded. What happens to their slightly wounded?—for apparently they don't return, as ours do.

In the meantime we hear that more reinforcements are coming from India. This is only a rumor, but has some substantive backing. Moreover, unless the Bulgarians are smacked and we renew our pressure on the Dardanelles we shall be needing them. We had our suspicions re Bulgaria after Nasirich on July 24, when we found that the three big guns captured by us had the three shridu cmrpy tmhnm had just arrived from Adrianople. They would hardly have taken guns from there unless they had been pretty confident about Bulgaria's intentions.

We have had a certain amount of excitement and have forced back the Turks from their advanced position, and we are no longer worried by their guns, wrote the officer to his mother a few days later. A night march with two-thirds of our force and a blow on their left flank at dawn drove the 24,000 opposed to us in headlong flight through their main position, in which they didn't stop, and on to Bagdad. Not doing them much real harm, but frightening the life out of them. I had the responsible and rather jumpy job of fixing up the starting-point.

I haven't time to explain what I mean technically, but it involved work outside the entrenchments.
