SEALING STEAMER WITH \$50,000 CARGO ABOARD, ASHORE. ST. JOHN'S, N. F., March 26.—With a catch of 24,000 seals, valued at \$50,000 on board, the steamer Viking, with a crew of 187 men, is ashore of the French Island of St. Pierre. The crew is safe, it is understood, but it is feared that the Viking, which is commanded by the father of Captain "Bob" Bartlett, of the Arctic steamer Roosevelt, will be a total loss. The steamer Prosper, from St. Pierre, and a wrecking tug, from St. Pierre, have gone to the assistance of the Viking's crew and will make an attempt to float the vessel. The Viking was homeward bound from the sealing grounds in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

CHATHAM MAN BADLY INJURED. CHATHAM, N. B., March 26.—Michael Losier, of Chatham, was seriously injured today in Walsh's quarry, across the river from here. He, in some manner, got his foot caught in a wire rope and it threw him over the embankment, a distance of forty feet, causing a cut four or five inches long in the head, his spine was badly injured and he sustained other painful bruises. He was taken to Hotel Dieu Hospital and Dr. Duffy was called to attend him. He is not out of danger yet. This is the second accident in two days as another man had a narrow escape from death at the same place yesterday.

MINISTER ACQUITTED OF MANY CHARGES. TORONTO, March 26.—Dev. David Hicks, formerly a Methodist minister of Gesto, now in charge at Corunna, Mich., was tried by a church court at Essex today on charges of fraud, falsehood and leaving his charge in an irregular manner, preferred by members of his Gesto congregation. He was acquitted and will resume his charge at Corunna.

NOTES RE THE AUTOMOBILE QUESTION. The Auto as a source of revenue. The Automobile problem has become very important to Massachusetts, the number of registered autos having increased from 3,500 in 1903 to nearly 25,000 last year. These machines are under the direction and control of the Highway Commission, which issues licenses to operate them, or revotes them, and keeps a register. A tax is placed on each machine, based upon its horse-power, of 50 cents per horse-power. The tax yielded \$350,000 a year, which was spent by the commission in maintaining the roads. When a person is injured by an Automobile, the operator's license is suspended, and not restored until it is shown that the accident was due to serious fault of the person so injured. The auto is the safest vehicle on the road, because it is always under control while the horse is frequently driven with a loose rein and thus liable to do serious damage. The motorist is not the subject to paying a tax for the maintenance of roads as is done in most countries. Horses would grow accustomed to the Automobile in most cases quicker than the driver, and roads could be built of material of greater specific gravity, and used. The motor-car would be very useful on the farm, one car doing the work of six teams at a very much smaller cost. It has come to stay. The Auto helps to produce good roads, and good roads increase the value of farms. Exch.

OTTAWA, March 26.—The Dominion Rifle Association has decided to allow the extended peep sight this year at the annual matches. This sight was allowed last year at Bisley. The sight is within two inches of the eye and it is attached to the rifle near the end of the bolt instead of on the regular back sight bed. On the Lee-Enfield rifle the peep was at a distance where the shooter sighted regularly, is, and on the Ross A. the bridge is authorized to extend over the bolt at the same distance back. It will be left optional with the riflemen, of course, whether they use this or keep the old V. sight. The announcement is made at this early date so that all riflemen who intend coming to the D. R. A. may have an opportunity of practicing with the peep sight.
