Among the significant moves that follow the rumors of possible Russian aggressions in the east are the despatch of Lord Kitchener to India and the order for the powerful British Mediterranean fleet to take up strategical positions.

An anonymous Conservative writes to the Examiner dissenting from our statement that the proposed deal with the Dominion Packing Company is not a party question. We formed our judgment from the large number of Liberals of the first prominence who are publicly and strenuously opposed to the deal.

The Patriot of yesterday had not a word to say in favor of guaranteeing the Dominion Packing Company's bonds, but we notice that its interviews are: quiting in the direction of a "bonus" instead. But it is to be observed that when the guarantee is once abandoned the original agreement is nullified and it becomes the duty of the Government to make the best bargain they can in the interest of the people.

It is again given out that Marconi is about to sail for Cape Breton, and an impatient public is not a little anxious for his arrival. In view of what was promised some months ago the advent of the trans-Atlantic wireless telegraph has been sadly delayed.

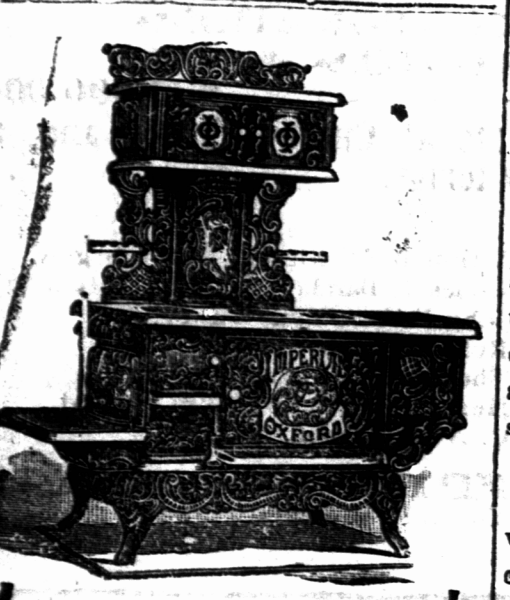
