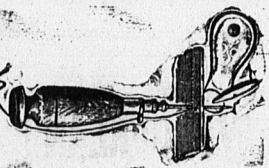

The Island Revenue Department of the Dominion has issued a bulletin on the inspection of milk from samples collected during the summer. The average percentage of genuine milk is 82 which is higher than any previous inspection. Toronto and British Columbia stand out prominently as districts in which the milk supply is of very low quality. The percentage for Toronto is 45; that for British Columbia 53. Calgary, London, Ottawa and Kingston head the list with 100 per cent; Montreal comes next with 97; New Brunswick 90; Nova Scotia 83; St. Hyacinthe 77; Prince Edward Island 73 and Quebec 69. Of the 343 samples, 171 were normal, 111 abnormal, 33 skimmed, 21 watered and four doubtful.
