In the early '80s he came to Florida with his father and the other members of his family. They took up their residence in St Augustine and he soon entered the grocery business with his father and the late George Myers, the firm first being known as George Myers & Co., and later changing to the Hotel Supply Company.

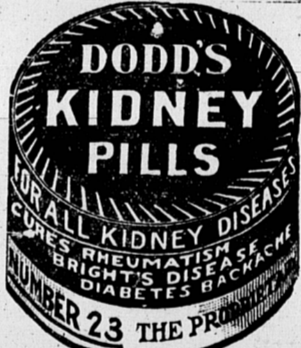

LONDON, Jan. 31--The parties stand: Liberals..... 272 Laborites..... 40 Irish-Nationalists..... 82 Conservatives..... 270 Places to be polled..... 6

The Conservative papers propose a joint cabinet chosen from the most moderate men of both parties to carry on the Government for two years, and that a truce be declared in the party questions in the meantime.

A Royal Commission to investigate the country's fiscal policy and make recommendations regarding Tariff Reform is proposed. The newspaper scheme is not taken seriously by the Liberals, who, having won the victory, even by a very narrow majority, object to having their opponents dictate the programme.
