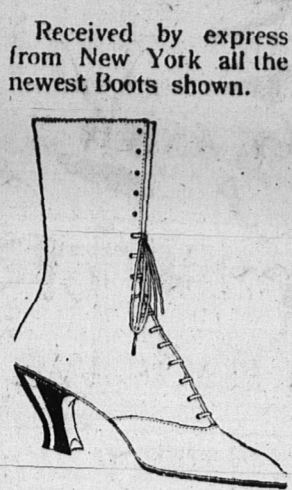

CANADIAN CADETS FOR THE IMPERIAL NAVY.

OTTAWA, March 28.—The announcement is made by the naval branch that final arrangements have been made for the special entry of Canadian cadets to the Imperial Navy. The regulations provide that candidates must be between seventeen and a half and eighteen years of age on the first of June of the year in which the examination is held. After physical and other necessary examinations the names of suitable candidates will be sent to the Admiralty. Final examinations will take place in England. Successful candidates will receive training for one and a half years when they will be given the rank of midshipman. A private allowance of \$250 per annum must be provided by parents of graduates from the time they join until they become acting sub-lieutenants, a period of three years and four months.

BELGIAN RELIEF WORK WILL CONTINUE DESPITE ABSENCE OF AMERICANS

Spain and Other Neutrals Will Redouble Their Efforts to Continue the Work of Victualing the Starving Millions.

MONTREAL, April 2.—Mr. de Jarlin, the secretary of the Central Belgian Relief Committee here, states that the withdrawal of Americans from Belgium will only inconvenience the work of the Belgian Relief Commission, but will in no way interrupt it. The work of saving the heroic Belgian nation from starvation, he says, is recognized as a moral obligation on humanity, and Spain, Holland and other neutral countries already represented on the Commission, have announced that their efforts will be redoubled in order that the work of distributing relief shall not be interrupted. The Commission has granted that the funds for the enormous work of victualing a nation of seven and a half millions are forthcoming as heretofore, they will see to it that the generosity of other nations results in the same successful and efficient distribution of food and the special feeding of school children as heretofore.

The Spanish Government has already announced that it is taking measures to this end, and the Spanish papers are warmly supporting the work. Here, for instance, is an extract from a letter published in the Barcelona paper, Justicia by M. Melguindes Alvarez, the Leader of the Liberal Democrats.

"The example given by Belgium in this war is sublime. History will record not only its heroic defence, but its national dignity. In opposing the violation of its territory, Belgium sacrificed to the world that justice possessed a moral value that civilized peoples ought jealously to respect. To defend this Belgium has suffered the devastation of its soil, the ruin of its prosperity, the burning of its monuments, the death of its sons and suffering of its women. Immortal riches, those who through fear or through egotism, are incapable of imitating its example, will remember its name with envy."

CARDINAL MERCIER LOOKS TO CANADIANS AND AMERICANS TO SAVE BELGIAN NATION.

MONTREAL, March 27.—When Cardinal Mercier recently ordered prayers to be said in all the churches of Belgium that the neutral Belgian Relief Commission should remain in Belgium, he looked confidently to the North American Continent according to a member of that Commission, for the material support which would mean that when Belgium is restored to freedom her returning government might not find her an empty husk, but a people of high spirit and regenerated ideals. In Europe it becomes increasingly difficult to get funds and food supplies, and in the face of this growing stringency is the increasing need of the Belgium people as their scanty supplies are being exhausted, and as prolonged existence on half the normal ration increases weakness and sickness. People here find it difficult to realize how great is the need of the Belgians. No fewer than half the population of Belgium—that is to say, a number equal to half the population of the Dominion of Canada—are absolutely and totally destitute. From day to day they cannot get one morsel of food which does not come to them by way of the Belgian Relief Commission. If there were such a state of things in Canada the whole people of this continent would be shocked beyond words. Yet that is exactly the state of things existing in Belgium, and nothing but whole-hearted help from fortunate nations living in plenty, as Canada is, will save the Belgians from the worse horrors yet.

The Central Belgian Relief Committee, whose headquarters are at 59 St. Peter Street, Montreal, are pursuing a vigorous campaign for the collection of funds to aid the work of the Commission. All the money contributed will be devoted to the purchase of food supplies in Canada to be sent direct to Rotterdam by a route outside the barred zone.
