



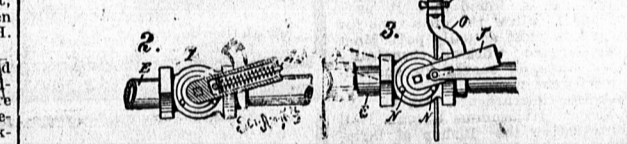

AUTOMATIC COUPLER FOR AIR-BRAKE PIPES.
 Pictured in the accompanying cut is an improved coupler arranged to automatically connect the air-break pipes of railroad cars in the act of coupling the cars. It forms a continuous passage for the flow of compressed air from one car to another without danger of leakage. The apparatus also comprises means for closing the air-break pipes whenever desired, as when making up a train.
