Stock Market Prices Dipped Slowly Yesterday

NEW YORK, Oct. 27—(AP)—The stock market operated in lower price territory today despite half-hearted attempts to pull ahead. Final prices were off by fractions to around 2 points. Most of the damage was done soon after the opening bell and the rest of the day was spent trying to recoup. The losses were trimmed in many cases and a fair number of key issues ended a bit higher.

Volume dropped below 1,000,000 shares compared with 1,140,000 Tuesday.

Offerings centred on the steel group largely because a widespread rumor failed to pan out. Many of Wall Street's experts had figured that U. S. Steel Corp. would come out with a special dividend after the directors' meeting late Tuesday.

Big steel's board, though, voted only the usual \$1.25 quarterly payment. Steel Common dropped on the west coast following the news but it was not until this morning that the New York market had its say.

At Toronto
TORONTO, Oct. 27—(CP)—Prices dipped slowly downward in active trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange today. Base metals slipped. Golds were easier as most of the action centred in speculative. Western oils held steady.

Base metals were down more than a point on the exchange's noon index but recovered slightly in the last hour. Consolidated Smelters lost 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 and Quebec and Noranda dropped fractions. Pend Oreille, Reeves, MacDonald, Labrador and Giff Lead were down 5 to 15 cents. Quebec Labrador, Silanco, International Nickel and Hudson Bay showed improvement.

At Montreal
MONTREAL, Oct. 27—(CP)—Losses narrowly edged out gains in fairly active trading by selected industrials today on the Montreal Stock Exchange and Curb Market. There were 10 issues with turnover of more than 1.00 shares each. Minco failed to establish any definite trend during active trading.

Industrial sales were approximately 44,900 shares while mines totalled 281,300 shares, an increase of 56,800 shares over yesterday's total.

Closing averages showed banks off .08 at 27.16; utilities up .2 at 75.9; industrials off .8 at 133.3; papers off .76 at 257.8 and golds up .18 at 60.45.

At London
LONDON, Oct. 27—(Reuters)—Sharp rises in copper shares provided the feature in the London Stock Exchange today.

This followed an announcement of a dividend of 13 1/2d against 9d by the Roan Antelope Company.

Other sections with the exception of oils, were easier. Losses of some pennies were widespread among iron and steel. Details of the Government's plan for the nationalization of the industry will be published next Friday. Meanwhile a little nervous selling is causing lower levels. Tobacco and textiles were also slightly lower.
