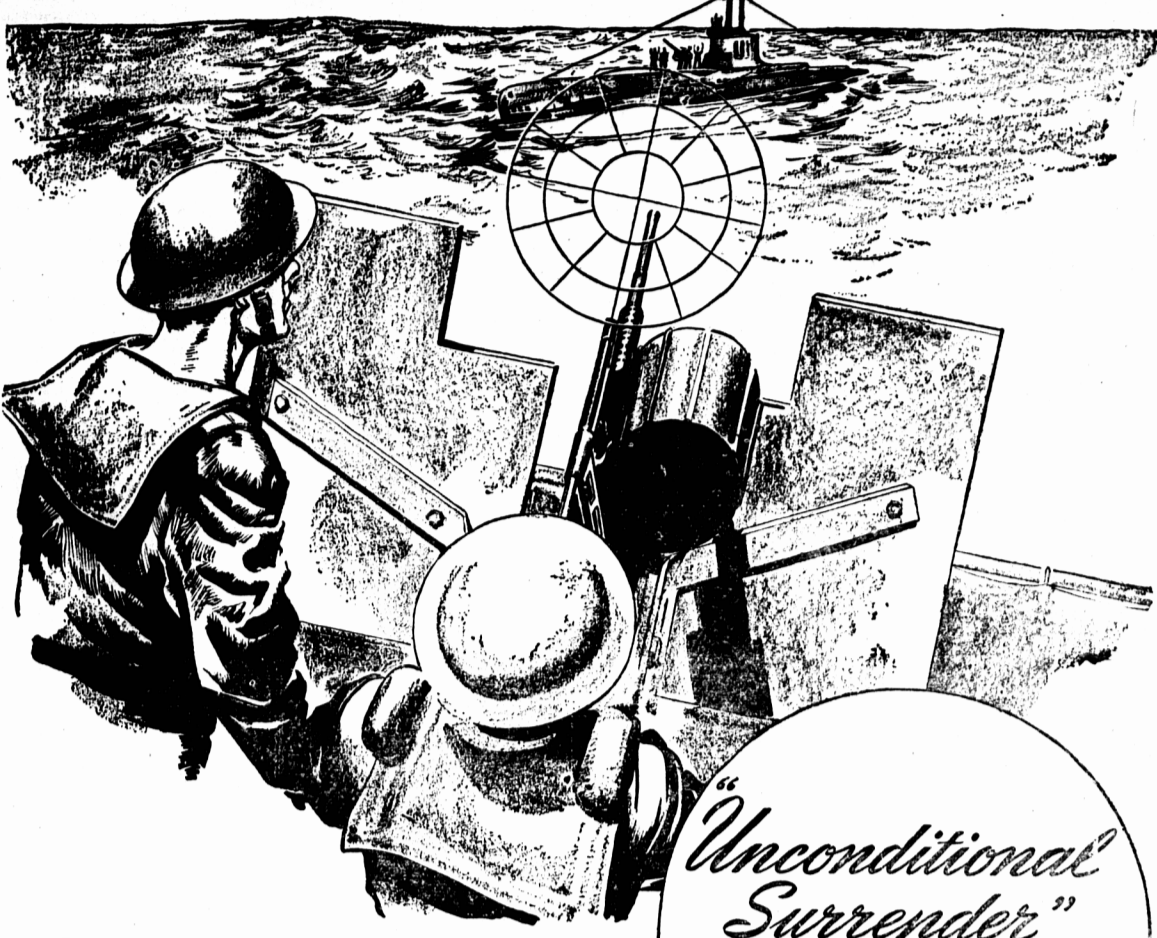

WAGNER—MACKENZIE WEDDING

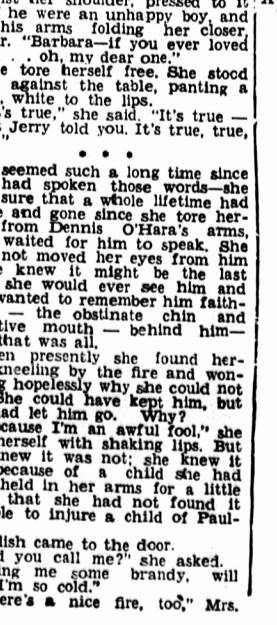
