ENCROACHING ON THE ROADS

From time to time this journal has sounded a note of warning against the encroachments made by land-owners upon the public roads and highways of the Province. This has gone on for years and what was at first the bad example of the few has become a wide-spread evil. New complaints reach us this spring, that in a number of instances the fences thrown down during the winter are being set up a little nearer the centre of the road than before.

In some cases we are told the fences have by imperceptible gradations got outside the telephone poles and although the latter when set up were undoubtedly within the public highway they now appear to be on private lands. The highways in this Province are narrow enough in all conscience and in many cases far too narrow, so that these continued encroachments by resident proprietors have become a serious evil.

The Provincial Government are the legal custodians and guardians of the public highways and are in duty bound to keep them intact. The present Commissioner of Public Works, as we know is fully sensible of his duties in that regard, and if we mistake not has issued some notices to trespassers in years past. He has tried to do his duty, and we should have to go a good way back among his predecessors in office to find a more attentive and faithful Commissioner. We say this because we think it his due.

It would be an unpleasant duty and one which any Commissioner or Government would be naturally reluctant to undertake, to exact a removal of the intruding road fences back to their proper location, and on this reluctance the aggressive proprietors seem to be presuming. But the time has come when the matter must be seriously grappled with and honest public opinion would, we feel assured, support such measures as will secure to our public roads their full legal width.

We deem it a duty to direct attention to this matter as one of serious importance, and as an evil that must be checked for the future and remedied as to the encroachments of the past. We hope and trust that the Government will deal

with it promptly and with a firm hand, not dealing merely with isolated cases, but insisting that what belongs of right to the public shall be retained and defended on the public behalf.
